

**Minutes of the Meeting of the International Confederation of the Society of St. Vincent De Paul (SSVP), Abuja Central Council Held on 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 at Holy Ghost Conference, Saburi.**

1.0	<p><b>Attendance</b> A total of 179 Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 11, 12, 13 &amp; 14 respectively.</p>
2.0	<p><b>Opening</b> The meeting started at 10.45am with a prayer said by Bro Sylvester Odogwu, the Council's special board member and Interim Chairman, Ozanam House Project Committee.</p>
3.0	<p><b>Spiritual Reading</b> The Spiritual reflection at the meeting which was based on the reading with the theme: <b><i>"Give with an open heart to your poor brothers (Deut. 15: 7 – 11)"</i></b>, from page 60 the new Manual of the Society, was taken by Sir. Patrick Ebhojie, the International Territorial Vice President for Africa 1.</p> <p>In his reflection, he stated that Vincentians are called to the Society and we should thank God for the opportunity to be in the Society. And as men and women called to the Society, we should give with open heart to our brothers and sisters in need and do not give coldly. As middlemen in performing charity in the church, we have the responsibility to perform our work with open heart and mind.</p> <p>If we fail to do that and one in need cries to God, he will be heard. It will be a sin upon you. Therefore, we are reminded to give generously and cheerfully not only as ssvp members but also as Christians.</p> <p>If we fail we will be held accountable first, as SSVP member called to do charity and secondly, as Christians.</p> <p>He further noted that sometimes we feel that we have heard one so many times and we try to reserve what we have for another case. Trying to hoard property or items is not in our nature as members of SSVP; rather we should seek out the actual cause of the poverty and plug it so that such a person will not come up again looking for our assistance.</p> <p>He also added that we should set up businesses and help the master run the business so as to not to run down the business. He enjoined members to devote their time and resources in doing this job which we are called to do because they are the gateway for us to heaven.</p> <p>He prayed that God will give us the right dispositions to do our work so that at the end, our actions will not be counted against us rather the crown of those who did the will of God will await us.</p>
4.0	<p><b>Opening Remarks by the Council President:</b> The Council President welcomed and thanked all for turning up to the last meeting of the year despite the distance. The location will enable us appreciate the terrain where some of our member are coming out from to attend the Council meetings and other activities. She noted that the meeting will take longer than necessary because of several issues on the agenda. She then appealed to members to exercise patient in the course of the meeting and also prayed God for a pleasant and fruitful deliberations.</p>
5.0	<p><b>Welcome Remarks by the Host Conference President:</b> The host conference president, Bro. Anyanike Benedict, in his remarks, welcomed the Council in the mighty name of Jesus Christ. He further remarked that since the inception of the conference about 7 years ago, they have been doing their best to ensure that the poor and the needy in their midst are taken care of to the best of their ability. He went ahead to appreciate the Council for choosing them for the hosting of the meeting and wished the Council a fruitful deliberations and joyous stay in the conference.</p>

<b>7.0</b>	<p><b>Matters Arising from the Minutes.</b></p>
<b>7.1</b>	<p><b>Report of the Inauguration of Our Lady of Fatima, Karonmajigi:</b></p> <p>Bro. Jude Aladi, the conference president reported that the inauguration took place on 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2019 and was very successful. He thanked the almighty God for making that making it possible for them to be inaugurated. He appreciated the Central Council and all those that witnessed the inauguration. He further reported that 2 additional persons have joined the conference since inauguration.</p>
<b>7.2</b>	<p><b>Report of the Inauguration of St. Ignatius of Antioch, Karu:</b></p> <p>The conference president, Sis. Ogbodo Patience, reported that the inauguration took place on the 10<sup>th</sup> of November, 2019. They had ten (10) new members on the day of inauguration and they will be joining them in their subsequent meetings. She further reported that the event was very successful although turnout was very poor.</p> <p>In her response to the report, the Council president decried the low turnout of members at the event saying that it was disheartening. She also stated that even though some conference presidents were preoccupied by the harvest activities in their respective parishes, they ought to have sent delegates. She however apologized to the conference on behalf of the Council for the poor turnout and enjoined members to always participate actively in the activities of the Council.</p>
<b>7.3</b>	<p><b>Update on St. Joseph Centre, Gidanmangoro:</b></p> <p>The zonal coordinator reported that they have not been able to meet with the parish priest as instructed to secure a space where they can erect a batcher to serve as store temporarily.</p> <p>The Council president in response to the report mandated the zone to meet with the parish priest before the end of the year and sort out the issue.</p>
<b>7.4</b>	<p><b>Update on St. James Dawaki:</b></p> <p>Bro. Azu Ezekiel, the secretary of St. Monica Conference, Byazhin reported they visited the conference in August and it was observed that the center has leadership problem. It seems that there is lack of trust on the leadership by the parishioners. Efforts have not been made to change the leadership.</p>
<b>7.5</b>	<p><b>Awareness Campaign at St. Matthew Ushafa:</b></p> <p>The zonal representative reported that they had a meeting but yet to fix a date for the visit.</p> <p>The Council president in her response instructed them to visit St. Matthew Ushaffa and report back in 2 weeks’ time.</p>
<b>7.6</b>	<p><b>Update on St. Donatus Dutse and St. Michael Sabon Gari:</b></p> <p>Bro. Chidi Egbuefu, the president of St. Theresa’s conference Bwari, reported that they have visited the Centre twice and they met the coordinator at each visit. However, the coordinator neither attends the Council activities nor sends delegates and unfortunately none of the members was present at the Council meeting. The Centre holds meetings on Sundays after 6.00am mass and they are about 7 members.</p>

	<p>However, he has no report on St. Donatus Dutse.</p> <p>Responding to the report, the Council president noted her displeasure on the kind of report being given by Kubwa zone and stated that seemingly the zone is not coordinated. She however instructed that they should do their job well and present a better report next time.</p>
<b>7.7</b>	<p><b>Awareness campaign at St. Matthew Gwagwa</b></p> <p>The awareness campaign took place on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 at their 6.00am and 8.00am masses respectively. Seven(7) persons indicated interest to join the Society. They had a brief meeting with the new members and informed them on the activities of the Society and also enjoined them to be committed.</p> <p>Furthermore, the zone had a meeting on the 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 and interestingly, all the new members were in attendance including the old members. Holy Family Conference, Life Camp is likely going to present them for inauguration at the next Council meeting.</p>
<b>7.8</b>	<p><b>Awareness campaign at St. Martin's Centre, Mabushi:</b></p> <p>The zone reported that the people that indicated interest in joining the Society after the awareness campaign are very busy. However, the secretary of the zone had been coordinating them.</p>
<b>7.9</b>	<p><b>St. Phillips Karmo:</b></p> <p>It was reported by the zone that the Center is made up of three (3) members who join St. Matthew Karmo at their meetings. Their masters are also being attended to by St. Matthew Center.</p>
<b>7.10</b>	<p><b>St. Joseph Centre:</b></p> <p>The Centre is the main parish but the Society no longer exists there. However St. Peter's Center has to stand independent.</p>
<b>7.11</b>	<p><b>Report on Lux Terra Chapel:</b></p> <p>Bro. John Okoro in his report recalled that SSVP does not exist in the Chapel but their alms box bears the name of the Society which they were told to clean. On his last visit to the Chapel he discovered that the SSVP on the boxes has been cleaned and replaced with "Charity Box" and with this the matter has been laid to rest.</p>
<b>7.12</b>	<p><b>Reports of Prison Visitations:</b></p> <p><b>i. July Visitation led by the Holy Family Conference, Life camp:</b></p> <p>The Conference president, Sis. Jumai Kwanashie, reported that their group is made up of 6 conferences namely: Holy Family, Life Camp, Guardian Angel, Lugbe, St Monica Byazhir, Kubwa, St John de Baptist, Mpape, St. Matthew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa, St. Donatus Sokale and Church of Annunciation, Gishiri,</p> <p>She further added that they visited the prisons in July with food stuffs such as bags of rice, bags of beans, cartons of tomato, cartons of soap, toothpaste, toilet tissues, bags of semovita etc. She also reported that a total of twenty-nine persons from the various conferences in their group were in attendance at the visitation.</p> <p>However, Church of Annunciation did not participate in the visitation claiming they are short of funds.</p> <p><b>ii. August Visitation led by the Holy Rosary Conference, Wuse:</b></p> <p>The president of the Conference, Sis. Eunice Akpolu reported that their group is made up of 6 conferences namely: Holy Rosary, Wuse, St. Johnmary Vianney, Kubwa, St Theresa, Bwari, Christ the king, Kurudu, St. Augustine, Angwa-Dadi, St. Fabian Efab Life Camp &amp; Holy Cross, Kuchingoro</p> <p>She also said that they visited the prison on the 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 and presented them with food stuffs and some cash donations contributed by the various conferences except Holy Cross Kuchingoro.</p> <p><b>iii. September Visitation led by the St. Damian Conference, Asokoro:</b></p> <p>The assistant secretary of the conference reported that they visited the prisons with some food items donated by conferences within their group. They also made some monetary donations meant to facilitate the freeing of some prisoners.</p> <p><b>iv. October Visitation led by the CKC Conference, Kubwa:</b></p> <p>The conference president, Bro. Albert Nzekwu, reported that their group is made up of the following conferences: Church of Assumption Asokoro, St. Agnes Wuye, St Jude, Zuba, St Paul Gwagwalada, St. Joseph, Kugbo, St. Peter's Abaji and Holy Spirit Byazhin, Kubwa.</p> <p>However, only members from 3 conferences within the group participated in the visitation. They visited with food stuffs and lots of clothes and also made some monetary donations.</p>

Responding to the reports, the Council president appreciated the various conferences that contributed materials and money to ensure they prison visitation was carried out and urged them to improve on their lapses during the next visits.

She also stated that according to the schedule, the November and December visitations will be led by the Holy Cross Conference, Gwarimpa and St Luke's Conference, Kubwa respectively.

However, she reminded the Council that the ArchBishop visits the prisons at the end of the year and it has been our tradition to join the bishop at such visits. She then instructed that for this year, the group for December visit will collate their donations and join the Archbishop during his visit to the prisons to represent the Council.

**7.13 Opening of Bank Account by Conferences:**

The Council President harped once more on the importance of conferences having a bank account for their daily transactions and also decried the flouting of the directive of the Council on the account opening stating that despite repeated calls for such, some conferences are yet to do so.

Various conferences and centers yet to open account gave reasons for their inability to comply with the directive of the Council. Some of them include:

**a. St. Lukes Kubwa:**

They reported that they have an account with Aso Savings but had to open another account with a commercial bank. Unfortunately, they suffered a delay as the application which they submitted to the bank for account opening was returned for some corrections.

**b. St. Monica Byazhin:** Bro. Gerald Ajoku reported that the new parish priest told them to still hold on.

**c. Our Lady of Fatima, Karonmajiji:** The conference president reported that they have submitted every document needed for account opening to Fidelity Bank except that one of the signatories to the account who is yet to supply his BVN. He however promised that they will get their account number in a few days' time.

**d. CKC, Kurudu:** They have completed the application form and submitted same to the Ecobank. Unfortunately the account officer misplaced the documents and they had to start afresh. However, they had collected and filled the forms again to submit in 2 days' time. Their money is presently being kept under the welfare of the Church.

Responding to the report, the Council President advised them to seek for another bank if within 2 weeks, Ecobank is yet to open an account for them.

**e. St. Ephraim Jikwoyi:** The Conference president stated they have filled all necessary forms and that the account opening process is 90% completed.

In her response, the Council president reminded him that he gave the same excuse at the last Council meeting and then gave him 7 working days to finalize the account opening process and report back to her personally.

In her general response to the excuses given by the Conferences and Centers the Council president reiterated her instruction in the last Council meeting that no financial assistance should be rendered to any conference or center that requested for such but does not have a bank account. She cited the example with **St. Peter Gwagwa Jiwa** who their parish priest wrote the Council requesting for our assistance for hospital treatment of some masters in their parish.

Conferences could not render assistance because St. Peter had no account and as such delayed the treatment of those masters. She reminded them that at such circumstance, the life of those masters are in our hands and we should do all that is necessary not to cause unnecessary delays.

**7.14 Ozanam House Project – An Update:**

Bro. Sylvester Odogwu in his report stated that the architectural and other services design are ready and wants the Society members to claim ownership of the project. He promised that every penny spent in the process will be accounted for. The project committee through one of its members was able to come up with 2 roll up banners which displayed the 3D design of the project.

He further stated that an access road is needed for the site which will include a bridge across a gully. The Bill of Quantity (BOQ) which put the cost of the bridge at N35.5 million is ready. He noted that initially they thought that a culvert will suffice but after due consultations with professionals, the bridge became the best alternative bearing in

mind the expected load the bridge will bear because the road is a major access to other plots of land, estates and other areas and not only to the Ozanam house.

They will explore the possibility of the LGA to take up the project. The bridge spans 26m in length and should be of standard.

The set of drawings (architectural, Electrical, mechanical, Structural) and other necessary documents (EIA, Soil Analysis) required for approvals by FCDA are ready. The committee was able to get people that assisted in the design at a reduced cost.

The architectural design and 3D of the building were presented to the Council by the designer, Architect Agatha Christy Irabor.

In her presentation, she stated that the building which is designed as two (2) floors contains the Skill Acquisition Centre, Hall, Refectory, Rooms and Dormitories for lodging, a chapel and other associated facilities.

At the end of the presentation, members asked questions and sought for clarifications where necessary. Suggestions were also made which include:

- i. Committee to ensure that other owners of plots in that area who will equally make use of the bridge should be made to contribute to the construction of the bridge.
- ii. The Committee to approach the Local Government to take up the project
- iii. Committee to seek for a note from the Archbishop to the Authorities for assistance

Bro. Odogwu informed the Council that it will be advisable that Grade A conferences put up the roll up banner in their various offices to serve as an avenue for awareness creation. He finally thanked the Council for listening and urged all to participate actively and see to the realization of the project.

Responding to the report, the Council president thanked the project committee for their selfless service and efforts put in to get to the present stage.

She further informed members the John Cardinal Onaiyekan, the Archbishop emeritus, laid the foundation of the project so many years ago. The board members and the project committee will find time to meet with the new Archbishop to intimate him on the project and seek for his assistance.

She then stated that all members should be part and parcel of the project development and as such contribute a minimum of N1, 000.00 yearly for the realization of the project. Members are to make this payment from next year 2020 to their conferences that will in turn remit it to the Council at the end of the year with the names of those that contributed.

Furthermore, a prayer for the realization of the Ozanam House Project will be developed and said at our conferences and at every gathering of the Council.

Finally she stated that if anyone has need for further explanations, suggestions, clarifications and questions on the project, such a person should not hesitate to approach the committee.

#### **7.15 Report of the National & Metro Youth Rally:**

The Council youth Coordinator, Bro. Fidelis Akomaye, reported thus:

- i. The 22<sup>nd</sup> National youth Convention/rally held from 29<sup>th</sup> August to 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2019 at Our Lady of Apostle Girl's College, Akwanga, Nasarawa State under the Lafia Central Council of Abuja Metropolitan Council
- ii. The theme of the 3-day event is "Rebuilding the Broken Walls, Neh. 2:17"
- iii. Day 1 activities include the arrival and registration of delegates from the nine (9) metropolitan councils and a courtesy visit to the Bishop of Lafia Diocese, His Lordship, Most Rev. Dr. Matthew Ishaya Audu.
- iv. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of the event a talk on the theme: "Rebuilding the Broken Walls of the Vincentian Apostolate-the role of the youths was given by Rev. Fr. Augustine Ashigabu. Other activities of the day include a quiz and saw-drill competition which was all won by the Lagos Metro Council. However, Abuja Metro came second in Saw-Drill.
- v. Day 3 of the event featured a courtesy call to the head of the Community, Charity works and visitations, skill acquisition training in soap, shampoo, detergent, shoe and paint making. A talk was also given to the youths on the topic: "Relationship and Marriage: the Catholic Perspective" by Rev. Fr. Micah J. Auta.
- vi. In attendance at the rally were 320 delegates across the nine (9) Metropolitan Councils. All the Central Councils in Abuja Metro Council were represented except Katsina Ala Central Council. The Abuja Central Council was represented by 55 delegates.
- vii. Ibadan Metropolitan Council will be hosting year 2020 National youth rally in August. Despite some challenges faced, the rally was indeed very successful.

7.16	<p><b>Report of feast day celebration at Holy Family Conference, Life Camp:</b>  Bro. Chika Mmuobike, the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice president of the Council, reported that the feast held on 6th October, 2019 and started with a Holy Mass at 10.00am in the parish.  Furthermore, during the Mass, the President addressed the parishioners intimating them on the importance of the feast and also what the Society does and what it stands for.  He further reported that at the celebration after the mass, Rev. Fr. Sam Umannah, CM, gave Vincentians a talk on how to handle the accounts of the society.  Other activities at the event include: drama presentation, dancing and cutting of feast cake. Over 320 Vincentians from the Archdiocese graced the occasion. The host conference was very hospitable as they treated Vincentians to a very sumptuous meal.  Overall, the event was a huge success.</p>

<b>7.18</b>	<p><b>Report of Central Council Training at OLQN Garki.</b></p> <p>Bro. She noted that the turnout was encouraging and equally apologized for the shortage of training materials and instructed that those who did not get materials should meet with the Council Secretary to put down their names so that the materials will be delivered to the at the next Council meeting.</p>

The proposed estimate which invariably points at the expected income the Council has been broken down to determine the annual contribution by each Conference and Centers to the Council. The contributions, as usual was graded as shown on the table above.

The Council president also stated that some conferences have not paid their annual levies and what is more worrisome is that they are not even making efforts to do so thereby hampering the activities of the Council. She therefore advised that conferences should pay their debts gradually and should not allow it to accumulate.

**8.13 Members Profiling:**

The Council President informed members that the board has decided that it will be worthwhile to have profile of members of the Society and as such a form will be designed that purpose and circulated to conferences. This is necessary to be able to trace any member invade of any eventuality.

**8.14 Annual Report Booklet:**

The Council President informed members that a second edition of the annual report booklet will be produced by next year. This has become necessary because the 1st edition which is presently in use is being exhausted by conferences being a 3 year annual report. Also the 2nd edition will contain the recent amendments in the report format. Consequently, conferences are to submit their annual report booklet together with their annual report for the year 2019 and pick up the new booklet at a price to be determined later.

**8.15 Retreat for Conference Secretaries:**

The president announced that there will be a retreat for all conference secretaries at a date to be announced later. Conference presidents are expected to ensure that their secretaries attend the retreat as useful tips in writing minutes will be discussed. Person's will come out from the retreat and be able to write minutes that will not be difficult for a person that was not present in a meeting to read, understand and follow up.

**8.16 Metro Council Meeting:**

President informed members that the Council attended the meeting of the Metro Council on the 9<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 at Immaculate Conception Catholic Cathedral, Lokoja. An election was conducted which saw Bro. Patrick Ogolekwu emerging as the new president of Abuja metro Council. The new president who is from Oturkpo Central Council will replace the immediate past president, late Sir. James Akor and will pilot the affairs of the Metro Council for 4 years.

Other activities during the meeting include: Courtesy call to the Bishop of Lokoja Diocese and submission and presentation of half-year reports by the various central councils.



The president also informed members that Abuja Metro Council will be hosting the National Council board meeting on 6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2019. The venue and time will be communicated later.

**8.17 National Uniform and Manual of the Society:**  
 President informed members that the 355pieces of uniform bought by the Council have been exhausted. The Council has equally ordered and paid for 60pieces more but yet to receive them because the National Council is yet to produce.  
 She also informed members that the delay is due to the fact that the National Council can only order for production not less than 500pieces. So, they are waiting for orders from various Councils to make it up to 500 before placing order.  
 There is no information from the National Council as regards the Manual of the Society and this implies that they are yet to print more copies.

**8.18 Garki Zone Hospital visitations:**  
 The president noted that it has come to her knowledge that some conferences in the zone do not participate in the zonal hospital visitation citing lack of funds as the major reason.  
 She advised the conferences concerned not to stay away from hospital visitation because of lack of money stating that they can always pray for those in the hospital even if you don't have money to give. If you don't have money you can have the time and you can pray for the sick.

**8.20 Year 2020 Plan of Activities:**  
 The Council President also presented to the board the proposed plan of activities to be embarked by the Council in the year 2020. She then reeled out the activities, dates and location as detailed below:

She urged the conferences to prepare also their year plan taking into consideration the activities of the Council to avoid clashes.

**9.00 AOB:**

**i. Proposing St. John Mary Vianney(SJMV) Trade More Estate for Inauguration:**  
 Bro. Fidelis Molokwu, the Gwagwalada Zonal Coordinator informed the Council that St. JohnMary Vianney is doing excellently well, they are also very active in Central Council activities and he believes that they are matured enough for inauguration.  
 SJMV has 13 active members and they meet on Sundays after mass at about 11.00am.  
 Responding to the proposal, the Council president stated that the Council will see their annual report for 2019 and thereafter take a decision on the inauguration.

- ii. **Igbokwe Cynthia of Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama** observed that the water proof/nylon bag used for the Secret Bag Collection is not presentable. She advised that the Council look for a nice and presentable bag for such.
- iii. **Bro. John of OLQN Garki** requested that the Council include “How to Raise Funds” in the training for next year. He stated that many conferences need to be taught on how to raise funds in their parishes. He also advised conferences to try as much as possible to make their alms boxes to look neat, presentable and secure stating that it also attracts and encourages people to donate.
- iv. **Iwene Tansi Center, Pyakassa:** The Council was informed that a new coordinator by name Bro. Chidi Bartholmew has been elected
- v. **Church of Assumption, Asokoro:** Informed the Council of the existence of an old Center – Church of Annunciation Kpaduma and has been in existence for 10 years. They Center has been under their supervision and has Bro. James Ani as the Vice Coordinator. They meet on Mondays after 6.00pm mass.  
  
In her response, the Council president stated that the Center cannot be baby forever and that they have a duty to make them stand on their own.
- vi. **Sir. Emmanuel Ajewole:** Thanked the President and the Council for their prayers and well wishes during period he was on medical tour abroad. He advised that Vincentians take the Society serious. He noted that the failure of people to execute assignments given to them for almost 3 months indicates that they did not put in their best. The Society is such that guarantees our salvation depending on what we did and what we didn't do.
- vii. **Sis. Margaret Egenti:** Suggested that the training for the secretaries should include the presidents. She also noted that conferences are more or less run by the youth who resist corrections and she suggested that we implement the age limit for youths as enshrined in the manual of the Society.  
  
She further advised that members should have the fear of God and be honest in whatever they do and try as much as possible to live what St. Matthew 25 said and imbibe a change of attitude so that we are not rejected at the gate of heaven.
- viii. **Bro. Calistus Ezike from St. Augustine Waru:** Suggested that Conferences also carry out freewill donations in addition to the Levy of N1000 for the realization of Ozanam House Project.
- ix. **Bro. Christopher Nzeh from St. Augustine Center, Lugbe:** Informed the Council that the Center has challenges facing them. He noted that initially they had full board members but along the line some left to St. Martins and Guardian Angel Catholic Churches which are in close proximity. And for about 8 years they have been 2 persons running the Society and normally carry out direct intervention i.e they meet at the point of collection of money from the alms box on Sundays and disburse whatever was collected to their masters. They have records of all collections and disbursements.  
  
He finally suggested that they attend meeting with Guardian Angel, Conference and they should assist them solicit for members.  
  
Responding to the information from the Bro. Christopher, the Council president urged the Gwagwalada zone to nurture the zeal displayed by him to enable the Center survive.
