

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SSVP) NIGERIA, ABUJA
CENTRAL COUNCIL HELD ON 15TH JULY, 2017 AT SS. PETER & PAUL CONFERENCE, NYANYA.**

1.0	<p>ATTENDANCE: A total of 155 Vincentians was in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 8, 9 & 10.</p>
2.0	<p>OPENING: The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Sis. Eunice Akpolu, the President of Holy Rosary Conference, Zone 2, Wuse at 10.40am.</p>
3.0	<p>SPIRITUAL READING: The reading with the theme “Faith and Good Works” (James 2: 14-17) from page 36 of the manual of the Society was read by Wilfred Mary Offor of St. Mary Conference, Karu. Reflecting on the reading, he said that Vincentians cannot say they have faith without good works querying the amount of effort put in by Vincentians in the work they do. He further added that we must back up our words with actions as we perform our Vincentian work and prayed that God will grant us the grace and the burning desire to be good Vincentians. Speaking also on the topic, Sis. Joy Ohiagu, added that we should always put love in our work and strive to improve on the quality of the work we do.</p>
4.0	<p>OPENING REMARKS BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT: The Central Council First Vice President, Sis. Joy Ohiagu welcomed all present and noted that the Council President, in whose stead she is acting, is out of town. She went ahead soliciting patience from members and urging them to listen carefully, contribute meaningfully and take what will be discussed back to their various conferences.</p>
5.0	<p>WELCOME REMARKS BY THE PARISH PRIEST OF SS. PETER & PAUL CATHOLIC CHURCH, NYANYA: The Parish Priest, Rev. Fr. Francis Kale welcomed the Council, on behalf of the good people of SS. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, to his Parish. He apologized for not hosting the meeting on the earlier scheduled date, attributing it to the fact that the statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary (BVM) was hosted by the parish and there was also an exposition of the blessed sacrament. He also said that, as Catholics, our relationship with the BVM cannot be compromised and thanked the Central Council for welcoming the shift in the date with humility. He went further to say that the conference in his parish is doing their best and their presence is felt. This accounts for the reason for support for the programs and activities of SSVP by the parish. He sometimes sympathizes with them on the enormous work they are faced with due to the peculiarity of the environment. He also said that he had been enjoying the guidance and collaboration of SSVP in handling the less privileged and the needy which made his burden light. He confessed that he would have caused a lot of confusion had he gone the way he wanted in the parish if not for the guidance of the SSVP. Finally, he pledged to subscribe for goodwill message in the 400th Anniversary brochure. Responding to these remarks, the Council 1st Vice President thanked the parish priest for his support to the conference and urged him not to relent. She also urged the conference to take advantage of the support they are enjoying from the parish priest and excel in their services to the poor and the needy.</p>
6.0	<p>WELCOME REMARKS BY THE HOST CONFERENCE: The Conference president, Bro. Amaco Andrew, in his speech welcomed the Council to his conference noting that they are pleased to have the Council in their midst. He equally prayed for fruitful deliberations and for journey mercies for all.</p>
7.0	<p>READING, OBSERVATION, AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES: The minutes of the previous meeting held at St. Mathew Conference, Karmo on the 8th April, 2017 was studied by all present and the following observations/corrections were made. i. Item no. 12.5(ii), page 10: “Pope John Paul II Conference:” should be “St. John Paul II Conference “. 9.0	<p>MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES</p>
9.1	<p>Awareness Campaign at St. Joseph Conference Zone 7, Lugbe:</p> <p>The Conference President of Guardian Angel Chaplaincy, Lugbe, Bro. Steve Obiwuzie reported that the awareness campaign has been carried out at the two masses. The campaign was jointly carried out by members of his conference and that of St. Martins, Lugbe. At the end, several people indicated their interest in joining the fold and they were briefly introduced to the Society. He has followed up the awareness campaign by sending some of his members to join the conference at their meetings and has been referring clients within their jurisdiction to them. He finally informed the Council that the conference is doing well.</p>
9.2	<p>Apology letters from St. Damian Conference, Asokoro:</p> <p>On the apology letter from members of St. Damian Conference, it was reported that some of those concerned are yet to submit their apology letters to the Council.</p> <p>In view of the above, the Council decided that the apologies should be submitted to the Council on or before the next Central Council meeting. And failure to do so will constrain the Council to consider that they people involved have decided to leave the fold.</p>
9.3	<p>Update on the 400th Anniversary of the Birth of Vincentian Charism:</p> <p>The Council's 1st Vice President informed members that the Committee for 400th Anniversary of the birth of the Vincentian Charism has been meeting and 6th to 8th of October have been chosen for the event at Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Pro Cathedral, Garki. It is a worldwide event and the Vincentian Family in Abuja Archdiocese is planning their own anniversary on the said date and will involve members from nearby archdioceses and Metro Council.</p> <p>In view of the foregoing, an estimate has been made of the financial implications of the event and have been shared among the various arms of the family. As expected, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, being the largest among the various arms has the largest chunk of the financial burden. Consequently, to raise the sum, Council has agreed on the sharing formula where Grades A, B, C and D conferences are to pay N20,000.00, N15,000.00, N10,000.00 and N5,000.00 respectively.</p> <p>She urged the conferences to make payments before the end of August and also informed the Council that T-shirts for the event will be available.</p> <p>On the Goodwill messages, the President appealed to conferences to help in taking up a space for goodwill message in the brochure. Those interested should meet with the Council Secretary. She finally appealed to those coopted as members of the Committee that have not been attending to do so.</p>
9.4	<p>Update on Metro Youth Rally:</p> <p>The Youth president, Bro. Fidelis Akomaye, informed the Council that SS Simon and Jude Minor Seminary, Kuje has been secured as the venue for the youth rally with the theme: <i>Repositioning the Vincentian Youth for a more Effective Service of the Poor in our Society</i> and will still hold on 4th – 6th August, 2017. The rally will feature talks, debates, visitations and cutting of the Unity Cake.</p> <p>The Council's 1st Vice President in her response stressed the importance of youth in the work of charity and the need to support them in their activities. She appealed to conferences to support the youth but however stressed that all conferences are mandated to send 3-youth members to the rally and any conference that</p>

	<p>fails to do so, must pay the registration fee. Uninaugurated conferences should also endeavor to sponsor their youth to the rally.</p> <p>She further informed the Council that the Central Council is the Chief Host and as such needs funds to carry out the planning. In this vein, she called out selected conferences and appealed to them for donation of fund for the event. Various amounts were ascribed to the conferences which she said the Council will be grateful if the payments are made within 2 weeks.</p> <p>Responses:</p> <p>St. Luke's Conference, Kubwa informed the Council that they have only 1-youth member in their conference and as such will be sponsoring only 1 person to the rally and therefore should be exempted from paying the mandatory registration fee for the 3-youth members.</p> <p>The president noted their request but urged them to do more to attract youth members to their fold.</p>
9.5	<p>Report of the Investigation of St. Linus Chika, Airport Road:</p> <p>Bro. John Okoro reported that they have been going to the conference for monitoring. They have appointed the Financial Secretary, Treasurer and Secretary but have not been able to get the consent of the Parish Priest for the awareness campaign who told them to tarry awhile that he had just arrived the parish.</p> <p>Additionally, Bro. George Nyitse reported that St. Michaels Conference, Piwoyi needs awareness campaign and have not seen people from the Central Council for that purpose. In a related remark, Bro. Christopher Chukwu informed the Council that St. Christopher which is under St. Linus Chika has been declared a parish.</p> <p>In response to the report and remarks above, the Council 1st Vice President noted that since St. Christopher and St. Michael have been under St. Linus Chika and the former have been declared a parish, and have also been inaugurated, they will nurture the later - St. Michael Conference, Piwoyi.</p>
9.6	<p>Update on Ozanam House Project:</p> <p>The Chairman of the Committee, Sir. Emmanuel Ajewole, after apologizing for coming late to the meeting, recalled that at the last meeting he reported that the committee will be paying a visit to the site on 22nd of April to do some assessment of the development around the area. However, the visit could not take place as a result of a later decision to accommodate some non-members of the Committee for the visit. Consequently, a new date was fixed for the visit on the 5th day of August, 2017. Those concerned are to assemble at Our Lady Queen of Nigeria at 8.00am.</p> <p>Report of the visit will be given at the next Council meeting.</p>
9.7	<p>Submission of Annual Report of the Council to the Cardinal and Spiritual Adviser:</p> <p>The Council secretary reported that the annual report have been submitted to the Cardinal and the Spiritual Adviser as instructed by the president.</p>
9.8	<p>Awareness Campaign at St. John Conference, Ketti:</p> <p>The president of St. Anthony Conference, Kabusa reported that the awareness campaign was carried out on the first Sunday in May. About 5 new members joined the conference.</p> <p>The Council president urged St. Anthony Conference to continue to monitor St. John Conference until such a time they are strong enough to be on their own.</p>
9.9	<p>Awareness Campaign at 12 Apostles Conference, Central Area:</p> <p>Bro. John Okoro reported that they met the parish priest for a date for the campaign but could not fix a date as there is no space in their calendar for July. However, he will inform them as soon as he gets a space for that purpose.</p> <p>The Council's 1st Vice President thanked him for the efforts but also urged him to meet with the Parish Priest in order to remind him for a date for the campaign. Surprisingly, no member of the conference was in attendance at the meeting prompting the 1st Vice President to tell Bro. John Okoro to send a word across to them that they stand to be penalized if they miss another Central Council meeting.</p>
9.10	<p>Awareness Campaign at Pope John Paul II Conference, Papal Ground, Kubwa:</p> <p>No member from CKC Conference, Kubwa assigned to lead the campaign was available to give a report. However, the Conference president informed the Council that they don't get information on the Council's activities. Presently they have about 11 members out of which 8 are active. She requested for the awareness</p>

	<p>campaign to attract more members to their fold.</p> <p>The Council's 1st Vice President in her response stated that CKC Conference, Kubwa has been assigned to carry out awareness campaign but that the monitoring team should join forces with them for the exercise.</p>
9.11	<p>Investigation of St. John Conference Mpape:</p> <p>The President of Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama reported that he sent his assistant secretary and Financial Secretary for the investigation. They reported that the Conference president is not dedicated to his duty and that his business is taking most of his time that the Society's work is neglected to the background. They also observed that he comes late to meetings and anybody holds forth for him and the spiritual talk is mostly from the bible and not from the manual.</p> <p>They further reported that the parish priest is not cooperating with them and they are not allowed to beat their poor boxes after mass. In fact, the parish priest told them to be doing the work of charity from their pockets. The attendance to meetings is very poor, recording about 4-5 members at each meeting.</p> <p>He went ahead to suggest that special training be organized for the conference members to guide them on how to run a conference. He equally suggested that Council should talk to the priest if possible.</p> <p>Responding to the report, Bro. Amaechi Ezeh suggested that the priest should be approached to enlighten him on the workings of the Society before organizing awareness campaign. Also, Sir. Emmanuel Ajewole noted that the fundamental work of the Church is Charity and all ordained priests know the role of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in the Church.</p> <p>The 1st Vice President, in her response said that St. John Mpape needs assistance based on their location but before approaching the Parish Priest for anything, the conference has to be working, they have to understand what the Society is all about and perform their duties in line with the rules of the Society.</p> <p>She then instructed Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama and the monitoring team to team up and work on the conference members to bring them up to a level that they can adequately pilot the affairs of the conference in line with the rules of the Society.</p>
9.12	<p>Update on Catholic Television of Nigeria(CTV):</p> <p>The Council's 1st Vice President recalled that Council appointed some members to represent the Council in the 2017 CTV Finance Committee and then called on the representatives to give an update. Incidentally none of the representatives was around. However, the Council Secretary reported that they have been representing the Council and that recently the Council has to pay some amount which is meant for a goodwill message subscription in the brochure being prepared towards the stakeholder's dinner for the Catholic Television of Nigeria by the Committee. The dinner will take place on the 19th July, 2017.</p>
10.0	OTHER MATTERS
10.1	<p>Quarterly Report:</p> <p>The Council's 1st Vice President called for the submission of quarterly report and informed those that are unable to submit to do so before the end of the month or pay a fine of N2, 000 for late submission.</p>
10.2	<p>Amended Report Format from National Council:</p> <p>Members were informed by the 1st Vice President that the National Council has carried out some amendments in the annual report format and as such the Council's annual report format will be amended accordingly to reflect the changes.</p> <p>However, these changes will be explained in details to members at the next Council training and the 19th day of August, 2017 has been tentatively fixed for the training at Holy Rosary Conference, Wuse.</p>
10.3	<p>Report of the AGM:</p> <p>The 1st Vice President reported that the 39th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the International Confederation of the Society of Saint Vincent De Paul, (ICSSVP) Nigeria held from 27th to 30th April, 2017 at the Catholic Pastoral Centre, Auchi, Edo State.</p> <p>The theme of the AGM was <i>“Economic Recession: The Challenges Before the Society of Saint Vincent De Paul (SSVP) In Nigeria”</i></p> <p>Decisions taken at the AGM include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Annual membership dues of N1,000.00 to be paid by members

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ii. All the Metropolitan Councils apart from Abuja to re-present their 2016 Annual report within 1 month using the current annual report format. iii. All the Metropolitan Council to get involved in funding and equipping the temporary National Office at the papal ground, Kubwa Abuja. iv. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul National Council website, www.ssvpnigeria.org, is now functional v. The reviewed 4th edition of SSVP manual was ratified and approved for presentation to CGI for formal approval before printing and distribution. vi. The National uniform template is a trade mark of the National Council and cannot be released to any Central Council. However, any Council that has capacity should liaise with the National Council for production of the uniforms. vii. Nigeria now has 990 active Aggregated Conferences viii. Nigeria National Council now has 5 positions at the International Council. Namely: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Commissioner, International Council on Aid and Development ▪ International Territorial Vice President for Africa ▪ Africa Coordinator, International Twinning ▪ Special Projects Coordinator, Africa 1 ▪ Territorial Training/Formation Coordinator Africa 1
10.4	<p>Report from Sir. Patrick Ebhojie-The International Territorial Vice President for Africa 1: He reported that he recently attended an International Council meeting where some issues were discussed and some decisions reached. Some of these issues and decisions include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Aggregation and Institution: Henceforth, Conferences and Councils/Particular Councils has to apply for re- aggregation and re-institution for every 5years and 10 years respectively. ii. Splitting of Conferences: The idea that conferences are not expected to be more than 20 and those that have exceeded this number should split was extensively deliberated upon, with diverse views. However, the issue was put on hold for further deliberations in future. iii. There will be an international gathering of the youth in Spain in June 2018. At least 1 youth from every country is expected to be in attendance. iv. New logo is being designed for the Society. v. International Council is encouraging website development by the various strata of the Society.
10.50	<p>Monitoring of Conferences-Zonal Reports:</p>
10.51	<p>Garki Zone: Bro. John Okoro reported that they visited the following conferences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. St. Francis, Galadimawa: Discovered a lot of abnormalities and suggests that St. Christopher Games Village to nurture and monitor them. ii. Holy Cross, Apo: Conference has issues with the parish priest. They promised to have a meeting with the Parish Priest. iii. New Conferences: Introduced St. Peter, Damangaza and St. Theresa, Wumba. To be nurtured and monitored by the zone. <p>Responding to the report, the president thanked the zone for a good job and also stated that monitoring teams can co-opt more members into their fold to make the job easier. However, it was agreed that St. Christopher Games Village will nurture and monitor St. Augustine Sun City Estate as well as St. Francis Galadimawa while Guardian Angel Conference Lugbe is to nurture St. Michael, Piwoyi.</p>
10.52	<p>Lugbe Zone: Bro. Fidelis Molokwu reported that they paid a visit to the conferences below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. St. John Mary Vianney- Trademore Estate: Carried out awareness campaign. Trying to build the conference as they are not aware of the rules of the Society. ii. St. Monica Sauka: A conference being nurtured and monitored by St. Martin conference, Lugbe iii. St. Mary Tudun Wada: A conference being nurtured and monitored by St. Martin conference Lugbe iv. St. Joseph Zone 7, Lugbe: Inaugurated conference

	<p>They visited the conferences above and discovered some anomalies bordering on conduct of meetings, usage of account record booklets, writing of minutes of meetings etc. which they corrected.</p> <p>Responding to the report, the 1st Vice president remarked that monitoring is not only for uninaugurated conferences but also for the inaugurated conferences.</p>
10.53	<p>Life Camp Zone: No report from the Zone</p>
10.54	<p>Kubwa Zone: Bro. Henry Enwerem reported that the monitoring team was able to visit about 16 conferences within their area of coverage. Discovered that most of the conferences visited have their account record booklets unfilled as expected and also some of the conferences has their financial records not well kept.</p>
10.55	<p>Karu Zone: Bro. Bonaventure Nwokpor reported that they visited some conferences within their zone and also adopted the strategy of not giving the conference a prior notice. During the visit they made several observations which include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Some of the conferences are not aligning their operations with the specifications of the Central Council • Some of the conferences don't read the financial report at meetings • Members come very late and at will to meetings <p>Challenges: Some conferences are very far away and hold their meetings at late hours. The committee members find it difficult to reach such conferences. He suggested coopting members that are closer to such conferences.</p>
11.0	REPORTS FROM CONFERENCES:
11.1	<p>St. Anthony Kabusa: Reported that they had their election on 30th June and Bro. Johnson Akubo was elected as the new president of the conference.</p>
11.2	<p>Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Conference, Area 3 Garki: The president of the conference informed the Council that they have gotten a bus from the goodwill of members of the parish. There was a strong collaboration between the conference and the parish that eventually materialized in the purchase of the bus.</p>
11.3	<p>St. Mary Conference, Karu: The president of the conference reported that they lost a client by name, Innocent Ehirim. He further informed the Council that the Cardiovascular team of doctors was at their conference for medical outreach. He decried the reluctance of conferences to key in to the programme which was free of charge even after adequate information was circulated.</p>
11.4	<p>St. Patrick Anagada, Conference: The coordinator reported that they are a new conference and not yet twinned and inaugurated. Requested for awareness campaign.</p>
11.5	<p>St. Theresa Conference, Bwari: The conference president, Bro. Imuse Magnus reported that Bro. Chidi Egbulefu has been appointed as the Vice President of the Conference, replacing Bro. Valentine Iloegbu. He further reported that they have new conferences they are nurturing namely: St. Michael Sabon Gari and St. Mathew, Ushafa.</p>
11.6	<p>St. John de Beloved Conference, Tunga Maje: The Conference President Bro. John Orie reminded the Council that they are yet to be twinned like other conferences and requested the Council to do so soonest.</p>
11.7	<p>Holy Family Conference, Life Camp: The Council Assistant Secretary, Bro. Jude Akubuo reported that they held their election on the 10th of July, 2017 and Sis. Jumai Kwanashie was elected as the new president of the conference.</p>
11.8	<p>St. Edwin Conference, Kubwa The conference coordinator reported that a member of the Zonal Monitoring team, Sis. Oby Adoro, visited them. The visit was timely and they appreciate her advice and corrections.</p>

11.9	<p>Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama: The conference president brought to the knowledge of the Council, their client, Mr. Ikechukwu Ohiri, whom they have spent up to N600,000 on his medical treatment. He suspects the client is shopping from one conference to the other and as such written to the Council alerting it of their suspicion.</p> <p>Responding, the Council's 1st Vice President reported that the Council never received such letters and such urged the Conference president to send in the details again so that it will be circulated to all conferences.</p>																																	
11.10	<p>St. Peter Conference, Abaji Reported that they are yet to see monitors at their conference.</p>
