

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SSVP) NIGERIA, ABUJA CENTRAL COUNCIL HELD ON 29TH JANUARY, 2017 AT ST. THERESA CONFERENCE, BWARI.

1.0	ATTENDANCE: A total of One Hundred and Sixty-Six (166) Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 7,8,9 and 10
2.0	OPENING: The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Mrs. Ezekwem, the president of St. Christopher Conference, Games Village at 12.40pm.
3.0	SPIRITUAL READING: The reading with the theme “ Reflect, Pray and Consult ” - From a talk by St. Vincent to his community, 7 th March, 1659– was read by Bro. Uzoagba Valentine, the Vice President of St. Theresa Conference, Bwari, from page 47 of the manual of the Society. Reflecting on the reading, he stressed that meditating on the word of God helps us to redirect our mind towards God. He equally said that we should always reflect on the thoughts and feelings which comes to us to be sure it comes from God by thoroughly scrutinizing them, turning to God himself for direction and also consulting experienced brothers and sisters for advice.
4.0	OPENING REMARKS BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT The Central Council President, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani welcomed all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. He thanked God almighty for the life He gave us, the journey mercies granted us and the opportunity to be at the meeting. He said that the meeting has to be shifted to 29 th , instead of 28 th as earlier scheduled because of the Ground-Breaking Ceremony of the Cathedral in the Archdiocese which forbids any other activity for that day. He further stated that the meeting today is basically for the submission of annual reports and stressed that Conferences are to understand the importance of giving accounts for the money received from parishioners and benefactors. As Vincentians taking custody of funds donated by the faithful, we should not only render account but also be seen to be transparent in our activities. Discipline and accountability, he equally stressed, are enshrined in our manual and that accounts for the reason why Council took time to give an in-depth training on annual reporting. He finally prayed that as we all work in the vineyard of the Lord; may He bless us abundantly.
5.0	WELCOME REMARKS BY THE PARISH PRIEST OF ST. THERESA CATHOLIC CHURCH, BWARI: The assistant parish priest, Rev. Fr. Chinedu Chijioke Majala, on behalf of the Parish Priest, Parishioners and the Parish Pastoral Council welcomed the Council to his parish and said that they are happy having the Council in their midst. He thanked the Council for what it is doing and for what God is using the Society members to achieve. “Those that dispose themselves will be used by God such as in the case of Blessed Virgin Mary”. He further stressed that Christ redeemed us and showed us the way, St. Vincent de Paul accepted the way of sacrifice and transferred it in such measure through us today. “Christ came to show us the way to sacrifice and we have accepted the to perform this sacrifice”. He also said that SSVP is a special arm of the Church, the present Vincent de Paul we are seeing today. He enjoined Vincentians to always do their work constantly and consistently all the time taking it as a life of sacrifice which ought to be done intentionally. He equally advised that we not be too critical in our investigations so as not to scare away those that may

	<p>seriously need our services.</p> <p>Responding to these remarks, the Council president thanked the priest for encouraging the parishioners to donate to the poor. He informed the assistant priest that conferences are today submitting their annual financial reports and that the Council is trying as much as possible to maintain accountability. In this regard, Council has introduced a uniform reporting format for all conferences to ensure a good financial management and reporting.</p>
6.0	<p>WELCOME REMARKS BY THE HOST CONFERENCE PRESIDENT:</p> <p>The Vice President of the host conference Bro. Uzoagba Valentine, representing the President, Bro. Imuse Magnus, who is unavoidably absent, on behalf of the members of the Conference welcomed the Council to their parish. In his remarks, he said that they are indeed honored to be given the second opportunity to host the Central Council since inauguration on 21st September, 2008.</p> <p>He informed the Council that the conference was established in 2005 and was aggregated on the 17th of June, 2012. He equally described Bwari as a Sub-urban town with some rural villages around and their clients come from within these places.</p> <p>He further stated that they have been “striving to spread available resources equitably in the best possible manner” despite the increased number of clients and dwindling resources being witnessed in recent times.</p> <p>Finally, he once more welcomed the Council and prayed that the gathering will impact on their conference and its activities thereafter.</p>
7.0	<p>READING, OBSERVATION, AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES:</p> <p>The minutes of the previous meeting held at Guardian Angel Police Chaplaincy Lugbe on the 26th of November, 2016 were studied by all present and the following observations/corrections were made.</p> <p><i>i.</i> Item no. 10.20, page 6: “Church of Annunciation Conference, Arab Road:” should be “Church of Annunciation Conference, Arab Road, <u>Kubwa</u>” <i>Corrected by Bro. Obi Anaduka.</i></p> <p><i>ii.</i> Item no. 16.0: Page 12, Line 1: “Next meeting was scheduled to take place at St. Theresa Conference, Bwari on 28th November, 2016” should be “.....28th January, 2017”. <i>Corrected by Bro. Ebuka Aganama.</i></p> <p>In the absence of further corrections and observations, a motion for the adoption of the minutes was moved by Bro. Phillip Nyam of St. Damian Conference, Asokoro and seconded by Bro. Jude Iwuagwu of St. Luke Conference, Kubwa.</p>

9.0	<p>MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES</p>
9.1	<p>Investigation of St. Joseph Conference Zone 7, Lugbe:</p> <p>The Central Council Secretary, Bro. Ugochukwu Anaedobe, on behalf of the 2-man committee set up for the investigation, comprising of Bro. Fidelis Molokwu and himself reported that they visited the conference on the 18th of December, 2016 at 5.45pm. Meeting slated for 6.00pm finally started at 6.35pm with 6 persons in attendance. He recalled that the conference was nurtured by St. Martin Lugbe and was inaugurated on the 29th May, 2016.</p> <p>They observed that the conduct of meeting was fairly good and the minutes captured most of the</p>

	<p>ingredients that counts for a good minute. However, membership is on the decline and the presidents' inability to participate actively in Central Council activities led to the conference holding their Christmas sharing on 24th December, instead of 22nd December generally agreed.</p> <p>The committee recommended that the president of the conference needs to do a lot to raise the visibility of the conference by creating awareness, motivating members and also raising the confidence of the parishioners towards the cause of the society.</p> <p>Responding to the report, the Council President frowned at the attitude of conferences participating actively in Council activities before inauguration and suddenly draws back after. He noted that the last Central Council meeting was held at Guardian Angel, Lugbe and wonders why St. Joseph Lugbe within the same vicinity was not strongly represented at the meeting.</p> <p>The president of St. Joseph Conference Zone 7 Lugbe, in her reaction stated that, she had been attending Council activities but said that she missed a couple of Central Council meetings because of some circumstances beyond her control. She also said that the membership drop in the conference may be attributed to erroneous understanding of the workings of the Society by some members of the Conference in which members are not expected to benefit from the purse of the Society.</p> <p>The Council president reasoned that a conference president should be a motivator, a good communicator and should also sacrifice more for the progress of the Conference. He then mandated the Conferences of St. Martin, Lugbe and Guardian Angel Chaplaincy, Lugbe to organize and lead awareness campaign in the parish.</p>
9.2	<p>Report of Investigation of Sacred Heart Conference, Airport.</p> <p>Bro. Daniel Makavah, the president of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Conference, Sabon Lugbe, in his report said that the president of the conference is no longer in Abuja but in Lagos. He contacted one of the members who said that there are presently three (3) members in the conference and they hardly meet for conference weekly meetings. He advised that there is need for awareness campaign to reestablish the conference.</p> <p>The assistant coordinator of the conference in his response to the situation of the conference said that when the president of the conference left Abuja, he lost touch with all that is happening. They had fifteen (15) members but hardly do you see them. However, they have priests who are supportive. He equally suggested awareness campaign as a means of resuscitating the conference.</p> <p>The Council president in his response to the report, enjoined mother conferences nurturing new conferences to ensure that there is enthusiasm from the members to move the conference forward. They also should inform the Central Council, before presenting the conference for inauguration at least 1week before Central Council meeting, to enable the Council look into their records and carryout other analysis to ensure they are ready and ripe for inauguration.</p> <p>He also instructed Br. Daniel Makavah to carry out a holistic investigation of the conference activities and thereafter pick a date for awareness campaign which the Central Council will be highly involved.</p>
9.3	<p>Inauguration of Our Lady Queen of Peace(OLQP) Conference, Utako:</p> <p>The Central Council president, announced that the inauguration of OLQP Utako will be on the 26th of February, 2017 at 9.00am mass. All conferences, he said, are expected to be represented at the event.</p>
9.4	<p>Report of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Conference, Gwarimpa:</p> <p>The president of Holy Cross Conference, who was assigned to carry out investigation was not available for the report. Deferred till the next Council meeting.</p>

9.5	<p>Introduction of the Newly Elected President of St. Damian Conference, Asokoro:</p> <p>The immediate past president of the conference, Bro. Phillip Nyam, introduced Bro. Ehi Anenih as the President the conference who emerged after an election which was conducted on the 26th of November, 2017. He equally introduced the board members namely: Sis Jane Okoh, present at the meeting, as the 1st Vice President and Bro. Emeka Offor, not present but is South East for official assignment, as 2nd Vice president. The secretary was also not present at the meeting because he had to stay back to conduct the conference meeting which coincidentally is holding at the same time as the Council meeting.</p> <p>The president of the Council in his response congratulated the newly elected president and enjoined him to lead the conference to greater heights. He equally informed Bro. Phillip Nyam officially that he should be attending the Central Council meetings.</p> <p>The Council president further enjoined members to always notify the Council when they are faced with serious issues instead of resorting to writing petition and conferences should avoid being at loggerheads with their parish pastoral council, parish priests or any other body in their conferences.</p>
9.6	<p>Apology letters from St. Damian Conference, Asokoro:</p> <p>On the apology letter from members of St. Damian Conference, Council president informed the Council that so far only seven (7) letters have been received and this development will be treated at the board meeting of the Council.</p>
10.0	<p>REPORTS FROM CONFERENCES:</p>
10.1	<p>St. Benedict Conference, Lokogoma- Christmas Sharing Report:</p> <p>The conference president, Bro. Linus Njoku, informed the Council that they had challenges during the Christmas sharing basically because the day for the sharing was a working day. They actually sought for permission to shift their sharing but was not granted. He suggested sharing dates to always be fixed for Saturdays.</p> <p>So many conferences also indicated they faced same challenges.</p> <p>The Council president in his response said that he discovered that despite the mandatory sharing date chosen by the Council, after due consultations with conferences present at the last Central Council meeting, so many conferences did their sharing on different dates. The Council, he said, is not happy with this attitude of disobedience to the Councils directives and strongly condemns and decries this behavior. He urged conferences to always adhere strictly to the decisions of the Central Council.</p>
10.2	<p>St. Mary Conference, Karu:</p> <p>The president of the Conference, Bro. Chuks Okonkwo, informed the Council of the difficulty in getting the conference being nurtured by them, St. Ignatius of Antioch, Karu to submit their report.</p> <p>In response, Bro. Francis Obukwelu the coordinator, claimed that they came with their report which they had submitted but was rejected because it did not meet the standards.</p> <p>The Council president in his response to this said that St. Mary's conference, Karu failed in their duty to guide the conference being nurtured by them properly but however urged them to get them to do the right thing and he also informed St. Ignatius of Antioch conference that their report has to come through the conference nurturing them.</p>

10.3	<p>St. John de Beloved Conference, Tunga Maje:</p> <p>The president of the conference drew attention of the Council to a case they are presently handling which involves a client who has undergone a surgery and needs a second surgery but there's no money to carry on and is soliciting the assistance of the Central Council.</p> <p>The Council president in his response stated that critical cases as this should not be brought to the Central Council meeting rather the Conference president should call the Council president to see a way to link them up to a conference that may be able to assist.</p>
11.0	<p>OTHER MATTERS</p>
11.1	<p>Update on the 400th Anniversary of St. Vincent de Paul:</p> <p>The Council president reminded members of the 400th Anniversary of our patron saint-St. Vincent de Paul and stressed that it is a unique event which comes once in a life time. We are opportune to celebrate our patron saint and as such the committee is already meeting and planning the activities for the event. He also informed the Council that members coopted in the committee will soon be notified and urged those involved to put in their best to ensure that the event is memorable and worthwhile.</p>
11.2	<p>Metro Youth Rally:</p> <p>The Council president informed members that the metro rally being hosted by the Abuja Central Council is scheduled to hold in the 1st or 2nd week of August, 2017 and as such a committee will be set up to organize a befitting rally. Members of the committee will be announced in the next Council meeting.</p>
12.0	<p>AOB</p>
12.2	<p>Seat of Wisdom Conference, Law School:</p> <p>The Council president observed that the Seat of Wisdom Conference has been operating without recourse to the Council and they have not been submitting reports. He finds the attitude very disturbing and not in consonance with the rules of the Society. The president of the conference was not available in this meeting whose venue is within his territory. The president wonders what is happening at the conference and consequently mandated the following conference presidents: St. Augustine, Dutse, All Saints, Dutse and St. Theresa, Bwari to investigate the happenings at the conference and report back to him.</p>
12.3	<p>The Arch Bishop's Visit to Kuje Prison and Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) Camp:</p> <p>The Council president informed members of the visit of the Cardinal to the IDP camp and Kuje prisons which took place within the last quarter of last year. The Archdiocese requested for contributions from societies in the church which includes the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.</p> <p>In view of the request, the Council donated the sum of N100,000.00 including 5 bags of rice donated by conferences such as Holy Trinity, Maitama(2bags), St. Damian, Asokoro(1bag), Holy Family, Life Camp(1bag), OLQN (1bag).</p> <p>He thanked the conferences immensely for their contributions and said the assistance was prompt.</p>
12.4	<p>Metropolitan Council Meeting:</p> <p>The Council president informed members that the next Metro Council meeting comes up on the 10th through 12th February, 2017 at St. John's Cathedral, Gboko. The Council will be represented by selected members of the board and all the Central Council within the Metropolitan Council are expected to submit their reports unflinchingly.</p>

	And as such, he urged conferences yet to submit their reports to so do unfailingly on or before Tuesday, 7 th February or face sanctions.
12.5	Depositing funds into the Central Council Account: The president also noted the difficulty in ascertaining the identity of some depositors through the alerts received and requested that henceforth conferences are to abbreviate their conference names when making deposits. For example, Our Lady Queen of Peace Utako can use “OLQP Utako” as abbreviation.
12.6	Uniform Account Booklet: The Council president informed members that any conference having difficulty in utilizing the account booklet should contact the Central Council’s 1 st Vice President or the Secretary for guidance.
12.7	Donation to St. Theresa’s Catholic Church, Bwari Council President, announced, for the benefit of those not present at the mass that the Central Council donated the sum of Twenty Thousand Naira(N20,000.00) to support the parish toward the fund raising for ordination of priests.
12.8	Announcement: There will be joint visitation to institutions by conferences within each zone on the 25 th day of March, 2017. Conferences within each zone are expected to liaise with each other to decide on the institution to be visited.
13.0	CORRESPONDENCES:
13.1	Death of a Member: St. Benedict Conference, Lokogoma lost a member, Mrs. Jacinta Ifeoma Ani on August, 2016. Masses are to be booked by all conferences.
13.2	Notification for Election: Sacred Heart Conference, Gwagwalada in a letter to the council informing it of their oncoming election for president coming up on the 25 th day of February, 2017 at the Church premises at 6.00pm.
13.3	Letter from Catholic Television of Nigeria(CTV): The Council received letter from CTV requesting the Society to nominate 2 members to be part of the 2017 CTV Finance Committee to raise funds for the CTV Satellite Channel.
13.4	Wedding Invitation: The Council received invitation from the President of Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Conference, Bro. Uche Offiah, for the solemnization of holy matrimony of his daughter, Valeria Nneka Offiah, coming up on 25 th February, 2017 at Our Lady Queen of Nigeria, Pro- Cathedral at 10.00 am prompt.
