2.0	OPENING:
	The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Bro. Emmanuel Eguriase of St.Charles Lwanga
	Conference, Apo at 10.41am.
3.0	SPIRITUAL READING:
	The reading with the theme "The Balance Between Two Extremes" - From a report by St. Vincent de
	Paul to the Ladies of Charity on the State of the work, 11 th July 1657– was read by Bro. Jude Iwuagwu,
	president of St. Luke conference Kubwa, from page 51 of the manual of the Society. Reflecting on the
	reading, he stressed the need to understand where to strike a balance in our activities as Vincentians.
	We should always strive to moderate our activities in handling our clients, knowing where to draw a
	line as far as our resources can carry so as not to stretch beyond our capacity.
4.0	OPENING REMARKS BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT
	The Central Council President, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani welcomed all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
	He thanked God for His grace that has been guiding us in our activities. He specially gave kudos to
	those that were able to make it to St. Patrick Karshi for the last Central Council meeting and those
	taking the activities of the Council seriously. "It is mandatory for leaders to attend Central Council
	activities and fine is now attached for non-attendance"
	He further said that the meeting today is strategic in the sense that it is being held in the parish of our
	spiritual adviser, Rev. Fr. Sebastian Musa, whom he said has been there for the Society whenever
	called upon.
	He finally prayed God to guide us to a successful meeting.
5.0	WELCOME REMARKS BY THE HOST CONFERENCE:
	The president of the host conference, Bro. Patrick Taiwo, on behalf of the members of the conference
	welcomed the Council to their conference. In his words, he said, they are very happy and highly
	honoured to host this Council meeting which serves as a forum where we come to remind ourselves of
	our role and responsibilities to the poor and the needy in our society and also where we come to
	fraternize as one body in Christ Jesus.

9.0 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

9.1 Inauguration of Conferences

9.11 Inauguration of St. Benedict Conference, Efab Lokogoma

The president of the conference, Bro. Linus Njoku reported that the inauguration took place as scheduled on 7th February, 2016. The event witnessed good attendance and activities went smoothly. They are doing their best to carry on with Vincentian work with 27 active members. He is grateful to the Central Council for the privilege.

9.12 Inauguration of St. Joseph Conference Zone 7, Lugbe:

Neither the president nor any member of the conference was present to give the report.

9.13 Inauguration of St. Rita Conference, Ndako:

The president of the conference, Sis. Maria Ogbolu, reported that the inauguration took place as scheduled on 19th June, 2016 amidst a very clement weather. She further reported that the inauguration was successful and the conference is doing well.

9.2 Report of the Central Council Training at Christ The King Conference, Kubwa:

The training officer of the Council, Bro. James Ishom, in his report stated that the Central Council in its bid to equip members with the wherewithal to face challenges encountered in the course of carrying out its duties to our masters and also to understand the rules and regulations of the society in order to take the Society to greater heights organizes training for its member's bi annually.

The first training this year held as scheduled and was hosted by Christ the King Church Conference Kubwa on the 14th of May.

The training topics include:

- 1. "IN GIVING, WE RECEIVE": Presented by Bro James Ishom, JP (Council Training Officer)
- **2. TWINNING PROCEDURES:** Presented by Bro. Emma Nnaemeka (Council's Twinning and Aggregation Officer)
- **3. COUNSELING:** Presented by Mrs. P.C Nwokenna (Counselor with Parish Action Committee on Aids (PACA) Our Lady Queen of Nigeria)

The training started at about 10:20am with an opening prayer and welcome remarks by the conference president and the parish priest. In attendance at the training were 260 members from 44 conferences in

Abuja Central Council. Inaugurated conferences registered 6 members while un-inaugurated conferences registered 4 members at the cost of 5,000 and 4,000 respectively.

The resource persons took 45 minutes each to deliver their topics and 15 minutes each for questions and answers session.

The host conference entertained all with sumptuous meal and drinks which was arranged partly with a subsidy of N120, 000 from the Central Council. The training came to an end at about 3.00pm.

He further went ahead to list out the conferences that failed to attend which comprise of 6 inaugurated and 19 un-inaugurated conferences. They were however mandated to pay the registration fees.

9.3 Letter of Appreciation to Mr. Ikenna Chukwueke:

The president reported that the letter of appreciation has been prepared and delivered through the immediate past president of Holy Trinity Maitama, Bro. Sylvester Odogwu. "It should be recalled that Mr. Ikenna Chukwueke from Holy Trinity Maitama fulfilled his pledge of N250, 000.00 towards the realization of Ozanam House project".

9.4 Report on the Central Council Youth Visitation to Shenegu Community:

The Central Council youth coordinator Bro. Fidelis Akomaye reported that the youth wing of the Central Council as part of its annual programme for year 2016, visited the Shenegu Community, a remote area in Zuba, Niger State on the 7th of May, 2016 for an outreach aimed at providing food and clothing to the indigenes.

The visit which was attended by forty-four (44) members from different conferences arrived Shenegu community and was welcomed by the indigenes assembled at St. John Catholic Church Shenegu. After visiting the community head, the coordinator took time to introduce the society and explained the purpose of the visit to the indigenes. Foods and clothing's were shared while the children had biscuits and "bobo" drink as they sang and danced with members.

He further reported that funds, food items and clothes utilized for the visit were contributed by youth members, conferences and the Central Council. A total of N79,350.00 was realized for the outing out of which N59,550.00 was expended leaving a balance of N19,800.00

He then appreciated the Central Council, Conference presidents and youth members that contributed to the success of the visitation.

9.5 Report on the Central Council Youth Training:

The youth coordinator equally reported that the youth training held as scheduled on the 12th day of July, 2016 at Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Pro Cathedral Garki.

Papers presented include:

- i. "Spirituality of St. Vincent de Paul Society" by Rev. Fr. Paul Oziabor Salami
- ii. "Basic Requirements of Christian Leadership (The Four Cs of Christian Leadership)" by Sis. Joy Ohiagu

Twenty-two (22) conferences were in attendance at the meeting while twenty-four (24) were absent among which are St. Martins Lugbe, Holy Trinity Maitama etc.

Through registration, a total sum of 66,000 was realized out of which 14,030 was spent leaving a balance of 54,970.00.

He appreciated Our Lady Queen of Nigeria for providing refreshments for the training and the Central Council for providing the writing materials and folders.

	He finally appreciated the organizing committee and those who worked behind the scene to ensure to
0.7	the success of the training.
9.6	Awareness Campaign to St. Raphael Garki: The president of Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Conference, Bro. Uche Offiah, informed the Council that the awareness campaign took place as scheduled on Sunday, 8 th May, 2016 at St. Raphael Police Chaplaincy Garki. The event which was attended by conferences within Garki such as St. Rita Ndako, St. Anthony Kabusa, St. Charles Lwanga Apo, Church of the Archangel, Durunmi, St. Benedict Lokogoma and St. John Keti was a huge success. The Council president in his response thanked all the conferences that participated in the exercise saying that there is strength in unity and number.
10.0	OTHER MATTERS
10.1	REPORTS FROM CONFERENCES:
10.11	Our Lady Queen of Peace(OLQP), Utako:
	The coordinator of OLQP, informed the Council that the centre which they have been nurturing has attained maturity and then requested for their inauguration. They have discussed with their parish priest and have selected 16 th October as the ideal date if approved by the Council. He equally pledged their unalloyed support and loyalty to the Central Council. The Council president while noting that the OLQP has been regular at Central Council meetings
	approved their inauguration but however said that the date will be tentative as the Council has a lot of activities lined up within that period that may clash with the date.
10.12	St. Luke's Conference Kubwa:
	The president, Bro Jude Iwuagwu, informed the Council that his secretary has gone on leave outside Abuja and hence a replacement has been made. He then introduced the new secretary as Sis. Chinwe Inyama.
10.13	Awareness Campaign at St. Ephraim:
	Sis. Grace Attah, the financial secretary of St. Kevin conference Jikwoyi, reported that they embarked on awareness campaign to St. Ephraim, Jikwoyi on the 19 th of June, 2016. The activity was a huge success as they were able to attract new members to the society.
10.14	St. Agnes Conference, Wuye:
10.15	The newly elected president of the Conference, Bro. Obi Anaduaka introduced himself and noted that this is the first time he is attending Central Council since election. He also noted that he doesn't get Central Council notifications and information and requested that his contacts be added to the database. He also sought to know if it is permitted to take photographs clients at the Conference events. The Council president in his response welcomed him to the Council and informed him that it is part of his responsibility to always see it as a point of duty that he attends Central Council activities. On the issue of photograph, he said that conferences are permitted to take pictures for their internal consumption. However, for any reason you may want to use the photographs externally (outside the conference) you have to contact the Central Council.
10.15	Our Lady Queen of Nigeria, Garki:
	The conference president, Bro. Uche Offiah informed the Council of the recent increase in the number of the needy due to serious hunger in the land and as such the feeding of the poor which happens twice monthly in their conference have now been reduced to once a month.
	He equally went ahead to advice conferences to maintain good rapport with their benefactors so as to

	shore up their financial base. They can relate with their benefactors through noting their birthdays and sending them messages and good wishes at such dates.
	Also to maintain good fraternal relations among members, conferences can maintain a list of birthdays of members so that congratulatory messages and prayers can be sent to them on such days. They are trying to put these into practice at their conference.
10.16	St. Joseph Conference, Gwagwa:
	The conference president, Bro. Munonye Richard informed the Council of his election recently. He has equally appointed his board among who are Bro. Eugene Bucham - Secretary, Bro. Nicholas Udeh-Treasurer. Presently, they conference can boast of about fifteen (15) active members out of which nine (9) are active. The Council president in his response congratulated him on his election and let him understand that he has a lot of work to do and he should try as much as possible to attract more members to the Society.
	He equally advised him to always contact the Central Council for guidance.
11.7	St. Mary Conference, Karu: Bro. Chuks Okonkwo, president of the conference informed the Council that his tenure will be ending by September and presently they are nurturing St. Ignatius of Antioch, Karu which has been in existence about 1year and 2weeks. He came to the meeting with the secretary (Patience Ogbodo) and the treasurer of the centre.
11.8	Guardian Angel Police Chaplaincy, Lugbe: Bro. Steve Obi, president of the conference informed the Council that they had their election last Tuesday (5 th July) and he was re-elected for the 2 nd term. He equally reappointed all the previous members of his board. He further informed the Council that they have a lot of sick persons they are presently taking care of.
11.9	St. Kizito Conference, Kuje:
	The newly elected president of the Conference, Bro. Daniel Asinge introduced himself to the conference. He said his major task presently is to get more members and as a result he is planning awareness campaign to sensitize parishioners on the works of the society. The Council president congratulated him on his appointment and let him understand that he has a major task of reviving the conference and lifting it to its former status as a very vibrant and active conference.
11.10	St. Monica Conference, Byazhin: Bro. James Ishom, the training officer of the Council and a member of the conference informed the council of the recent election in his conference that saw Sis. Chika Atep being re-elected. Also appointed in the board are Vice President-Akatha; Secretary-Sis.Joy Egwu and Financial Secretary-Sis. Ugoala Angela.
11.11	Christ the King Church Conference, Kubwa: The conference president, Sis. Obiageli Adoro extended the appreciation of the Parish Priest to the Central Council for coming to his Parish for the training. She also thanked the Central Council for the privilege to host the training. She further informed the Council that they had internal training 2 weeks before the Central Council training and it was successful.
12.0	AOB
12.1	Our Lady Queen of Peace, Utako:
	A member of the conference sought to know what they can do to clients whom after investigations,

conference decided to send them home to their villages but they refuse and demands for empowerment.

The Council president responded by saying that conferences should always learn to take a decision and stand by their decision. Such clients can equally be counseled but you should not force a decision on the client.

12.2 St. Mary Conference, Karu:

Sis. Agatha Irabor reported of the death of a client, David Ochaika, who has been sick for about eight years. He has since been buried and mass booked for the repose of his soul.

12.3 Vincentian Family Meeting:

The Council president reported that on the 25th of July. 2016, a meeting of Vincentian family was held at OLQN Pro-cathedral Garki. The representatives of the various arms of the family were present. Account has been opened for the family and he was made a signatory to the account in category B.

Part of the resolutions at the meeting include:

- i. Visit to Suleija prison to mark the year of mercy
- ii. The 400th anniversary of St. Vincent de Paul to hold next year and the family will convene and plan towards this programme.

They equally deliberated on the joint Vincentian family celebration this year to mark the feast of St. Vincent de Paul.

12.4 Central Council Treasurer:

The president informed the Council that the treasurer, Sis. Dorcas Angya has been transferred to Lagos and as such created vacancy in the board. A replacement will soon be made.

He further noted that Sis. Dorcas did very well as treasurer of the Council and that her commitment and dedication was very exceptional. An appreciation and send forth letter will be sent to her by the Council.

12.5 Remarks by the Special Board Member:

In his remarks, Bro. Nwaokeleme Frederick noted that the hunger in the land is so high and the resources are shrinking. He noted that in the words of our Lord Jesus Christ "the poor you will always have in your midst" and we are enjoined in our manual that no one should go hungry when they visit. In the light of these two statements he advised that the society cannot exhaustively handle all the cases but prudency should be the watch word. Let us not be discouraged and conferences should do their best and should not go beyond their capacity otherwise they will collapse.

12.6 St. Luke Conference, Kubwa:

The president of the conference Bro. Jude Iwuagwu brought to the knowledge of the Council of the 2nd collection in their parish in the month of May, tagged SSVP Collection which they never received any money from the parish priest after collection. He sought to know if the Central Council is aware of such collections.

He further sought to know whether those that did not attend the training will pay from their pockets or their conference will foot the bill.

Responding, the president said the Council is unaware of such collections but will make effort to find out. He also responded to the 2^{nd} question that presently the conferences will pay but the other option may be considered in future.

12.7 **Youth Reports:** 12.71 **National Youth Coordinators Workshop.** The youth Coordinator Bro. Fidelis Akomaye, reported that the workshop with the theme: "Combating Poverty: The Role of Vincentian Youths" held as scheduled on the 24th through 26th of June, 2016 at St. Peters Catholic Church, Ediba Calabar, Cross River State. Three (3) delegates represented the Central Council at the event. He further reported that the , Rev. Fr. Clement Okafor while speaking on the theme of the event defined poverty as lack of something and went ahead to list various ways of combating poverty such as prayer, writing and publishing, education, participating in politics, organizing skill acquisition and farming. The next youth coordinators workshop will be held in Kaduna Metro in 2017. The sum of N66, 000.00 was expended by the three (3) delegates to the event. 12.72 Information from Youth Desk: Jos Rally: The National youth rally with the theme "Vincentian Apostolate and the Year of Mercy" will hold on 25th through 28th August, 2016 at St. Louis Girls College, Jos. Each Metro is expected to come with 30 delegates out of which Abuja Central council will be attending with fifteen (15) delegates. The rally will witness activities such as skill acquisition, visit to IDP camps and a debate with the topic: "Decline in the Youth Spirituality should be blamed on the Church not the Parent" He further stated that the organizers are soliciting for goodwill messages from Metro and Central Councils at the cost of N3, 000.00 and N5, 000.00 for Half page and Full Page respectively. Youth meeting The youth coordinator Bro. Fidelis Akomaye announced that the youth wing will be having a meeting at SS.Peter & Paul Catholic Church on Sunday at 12.00pm. He urged the conference presidents to encourage their youth to attend. 12.8 Activities to be carried out by some conferences: The president informed the Council that it has been observed that some conferences are no longer as active as they were before and as such requires that the Council investigate to find out exactly what their problems are or to carry out awareness campaign. Consequently, the presidents of St. Martins Conference, Lugbe and St. Charles Lwanga, Conference, Apo are to investigate the activities of St. Linus conference Chika while the president of Holy Cross Conference, Gwarimpa is to look into the activities of Our Lady of Perpetual Help conference. On the other hand, St. Paul Conference, Gwagwalada and St. Kizito Conference, Kuje are to investigate the activities of Sacred Heart Conference, Gwagwalada and possibly carry out awareness campaign. The Council expects reports of these activities in the next Council meeting. 12.9 **Special Remarks by the Council President:** The Council president, in his remarks, centered on reflection on the spiritual reading of the day "Balance between two extremes" which was taken from page 51 of the manual. He said that the Society may not be able to handle all cases in their jurisdiction and as such should

always realize their limits. Conferences are not expected to excuse themselves from paying the Council

dues because of the cases being handled in their jurisdiction. He further reeled out the powers, responsibilities of conference presidents thus:

- i. It is the responsibility conference presidents to participate actively in the Council activities as they are board members of the Central Council.
- ii. Conference presidents are custodian of their various conferences and will be held responsible for anything that happens in their domain.
- iii. It is equally the responsibility of the conference presidents to pay the dues to the Council promptly.
- iv. Conference presidents don't need the permission of their members to pay higher council levies.

The Council president also advised the conference presidents to:

- i. Be firm with the rules of the society
- ii. Desist from ridiculing or making derogatory remarks against the higher Council.
- iii. Be sensitive to the needs of their conference members and always organize trainings.
- iv. Always cooperate with their conference patrons and consult the Central Council in critical matters.
- v. Report to the Central Council whenever you are incapacitated or incapable of running the affairs of your conference.
- vi. Conduct elections as and when due and inform your parish priest and the Central Council 6 months and 3 months, respectively before expiration of your tenure.
- vii. Uphold the integrity of the Society by being accountable and loyal to the Church
- viii. Not to work in isolation of the Church and other societies. The society is not more charitable than the Church and the Society is not better than other Societies in the Church. All are instituted by the Holy Spirit in diversity of Charism.
- ix. Take the rules of the Society seriously as it has earned the Society enormous integrity.
- x. Always remember that we are all here for our personal sanctification.

12.10 St. Damian Conference (Church of Assumption) Asokoro:

The conference president, Bro. Phillip Nyam drew the attention of the Council to the ugly happenings in their conference that has pitched the Parish priest against the leadership of the conference.

He said that St. Damian Conference, in the last four (4) years has been going through a lot of challenges which bothers on the parish priest's distrust on the ways the society handles its activities. Efforts were made to resolve issues and were thought to have been resolved until recently.

The immediate problem, he averred, is a standing order to the conference from the parish priest to handle all cases from him even if it is outside the conference jurisdiction.

Also, the parish priest, for reasons best known to him, decided to restructure the Society and as such demanded he give him six (6) names and later ten (10) names insisting he cannot work with a crowd which he declined.

At the last Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) meeting, the parish priest presented the issue and sought the permission of the PPC to choose people to work with and he got the approval.

He (conference president) was summoned by the Vice Chairman PPC to meet with him this evening. He had planned to inform the Central Council appropriately, of this development in his conference after meeting with the Vice Chairman.

Responding to this submission, Sir. Peter Aliu, the president of Holy Family conference, said that as Bishops decides for spiritual purposes what happens in his diocese such also goes for priests in their parishes. He advised that we have to carry along the parish priests in our activities and we should not be carried away by emotions and sentiments. The church is structured in such a way that the bishops and

priests are absolutely in charge of whatever happens in their jurisdictions. He advised that the Council handle this issue with caution.

The president of the Council informed St. Damian Conference president and the board members to wait behind after the meeting for further discussions on the matter.
