

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SSVP) NIGERIA, ABUJA
CENTRAL COUNCIL HELD ON 14TH MARCH, 2015 AT ST. AGNES PARISH, WUYE, ABUJA.**

1.0	ATTENDANCE: <p>A total of 102 Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 10, 11, and 12.</p>
2.0	OPENING: <p>The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Bro. Sylvester Odogwu of Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama at 10.25am</p>
3.0	SPIRITUAL READING: <p>The reading was read by Bro. Sylvester Odogwu of Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama and was taken from page 51 of the manual of the Society. The theme of the reading is “The balance between two extremes”. Reflecting on the reading, he said that as Vincentians we are called to have focus and understand what the work is all about and there is the need to know where to strike a balance in cases we handle. As we focus on the original course of our work, we should not refrain from putting Christ at the centre of our activities.</p>
4.0	OPENING REMARKS BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT <p>The Central Council President, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani welcomed all present at the beginning of the meeting. He urged Vincentians to always read their manuals to learn more about the Society and to understand mode of operation of the society in carrying out the work of charity. He equally urged members to take the manual as their guide and also be open to learn.</p>
5.0	WELCOME ADDRESS BY THE HOST PRESIDENT: <p>The host conference president, Bro. E.U.ljeh, most sincerely welcomed all present and note that the decision of the Council to hold a meeting in their conference serves as a way of encouragement to them. He also informed Vincentians that they receive tremendous support and cooperation from the Priests of the parish and the parishioners and this enabled them make much impact in taking care of the needs of their clients. Finally he prayed for the grace for fruitful deliberations.</p>
6.0	REMARKS BY THE PARISH PRIEST OF ST. AGNES CATHOLIC CHURCH: <p>The Parish Pastoral Council Vice Chairman, Mr. Phillip Akinfemide, represented the Parish Priest who was unavoidably absent. In his remarks, he sincerely welcomed the Council to his parish and noted that the society plays a very important role in the church. He equally disclosed their happiness to have the Council in their parish and also wished the Council fruitful deliberations.</p>

<p>7.0</p>	<p>READING, OBSERVATION, AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES:</p> <p>The minutes of the previous meeting held at St. Mary’s Parish, Karu on 31st January, 2015 were studied by all present and the following observations and corrections were made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Page 5: 1st Vice President- Joy “Ohiagu” not “Ohiagwu” ii. Page 8; No.4: “James Ishom” not “James Brown” <p>In the absence of further corrections and observations, a motion for the adoption of the minutes was moved by Bro. Amobi Ebhokam of Church of Archangel Conference, Durumi and seconded by Jonathan Maiyaki of St. Linus Conference, Chika.</p>
<p>8.0</p>	<p>MATTERS ARISING:</p>
<p>8.1</p>	<p>Progress Report on the Inauguration of Sacred Heart Center, Airport:</p> <p>The Central Council president reminded the Council that a delegation comprising of Sir. Ebhojie, Augustine Innoh and Fidelis Molokwu were mandated to visit the Parish priest with a view to engaging him on the stipulations of our manual and possibly resolving the matter. However, Augustine Innoh informed the Council that they’ve not been able to make the visit due to some circumstances beyond their control, but promised that a report will be presented at the next meeting of the Council.</p>
<p>8.2</p>	<p>Update on St. Francis Centre, Galadimawa; an Outstation of St. Linus Conference Chika:</p> <p>Jonathan Maiyaki, president of St. Linus conference, informed the Council the board members of the Centre have been changed and presently the activity of the Centre is stable.</p>
<p>8.3</p>	<p>Update on St. Paul’s Conference Gwagwalada:</p> <p>The Central Council President informed members that at the last emergency meeting of the Council, it was agreed that the Council will carry out awareness campaign, to be piloted by Sir. E.O Ajewole at St. Paul’s conference to sensitize parishioners on the activities of the Society and the need to support or join the Society. In view of this, 22nd of March, was agreed for this activity and all conferences were mandated to have at least 2 members in attendance and all should appear in the National Uniform. Members are to gather at OLQN and set out time is 6.30am. Conferences close to St. Paul’s, Gwagwalada should go straight to the conference.</p>
<p>8.4</p>	<p>Report of Metro Meeting by Sis. Joy Ohiagu:</p> <p>The Abuja Central Council on the 6th – 8th February, 2015, hosted the 41st</p>

meeting of the Abuja Metropolitan Council of the Confederation of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul Nigeria at Daughters of Divine Love Retreat and Conference Centre (DRACC) Sabon Lugbe.

Highlights of the meeting include:

1. Courtesy call to the Archbishop, His Eminence John Cardinal Onaiyekan,
2. Talk by Rev. Fr. Stanley Ekwugha on the topic: “Blessed are the Merciful: Rediscovering the True meaning of Compassion”
3. The introduction of the new Abuja Central Council President, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani to the metro Council by the immediate past president Paschal Ahizih.
4. Appointment of Bro. Albert Nzekwu as new financial secretary of the Metro Council(a position formally occupied by the new Abuja Central Council president) Albert Nzekwu was the immediate past youth coordinator of the Abuja Central Council.
5. Creation of new Central Councils of Gboko and Katsina-Ala bringing the number of Central Councils within the metropolis to 8
6. Spiritual adviser to Metro Council: Application has been written to this effect and submitted to the office of the archbishop for approval.
7. Aggregation and Twinning: Internal and International Twinning forms as well as aggregation forms should be filled and returned as soon as possible. It was noted that 1000 conferences will give the National Council a permanent place in the International Council.
8. Project: Conferences and Councils were enjoined to put in place projects that can be used to attract funding from international councils. A 3-man committee was appointed to coordinate the projects in the metro council. The terms of reference include:
 - i. To assist the conference and Central Councils that are already handling projects in packaging it to approval level
 - ii. See to the possibility of a metro project and suggest one
 - iii. Recommend ways of funding the project without levying the Central Council
 - iv. Recommend also the location of the project if one is identified and approved.
9. **Reports:** The Abuja Central Council immediate past president presented his

report which is about 70% complete. This is due to the fact that out of 37 conferences in the council, only 23 submitted their annual report. He however promised to update it as soon as other reports are available.

10. **Non-Submission of Reports:** Out of the 6 Councils present, only 2 Councils (Abuja and Lafia) presented their report. The Metro president who was visibly angry and disappointed at this development warned that he will invoke his powers, as enshrined in the manual, to remove any Central Council president that is seen to be non-performing. And this power also applies to the Central Council presidents and their conference presidents.
11. **National Youth Rally:** Metro Youth rally is slated for April at Lokoja. Youth Coordinator presented a proposal which stipulates 3 days for the rally to accommodate skill acquisition training. The proposal is awaiting approval from the board.
12. **2015 Budget:** Out of the total amount presented as budget for 2015 by the Metro Council, Abuja Central Council is to pay N211, 200. This amount is expected to be paid in June.
13. Next Meeting of the Metro Council comes up in August to be hosted by the Idah Central Council at a date to be communicated later.

8.41 Reactions from the Metro Report:

The Central Council president commented on the low turnout of Vincentians from Abuja Central Council. He pointed out that the Metro Council frowned at the poor turnout of conferences in Abuja Central Council. He urged members to be up and doing, and attending such meetings will enable us learn a lot about the society. He also informed conferences' that have not paid their hosting levy to so do.

The President also said that the late submission of reports by conferences affects the Councils submission of reports to Metro Council. Presently about 4 conferences are yet to submit their annual report. In view of this, it was agreed that 31st of January will now stand as the latest time for submission by all conferences otherwise the president will invoke his powers to sanction defaulting conference presidents. The 4 conferences that are yet to submit 2014 annual report were given up to Thursday, 19th March to do so.

Bro. Sylvester Odogwu reiterated the need to mail the format of report writing to all conference presidents.

8.5	<p>Inauguration of C.K.C Kurudu Centre:</p> <p>Sis. Evelyn Ataguba, the assistant coordinator of the centre, reported that a new date has not been fixed due to the absence of their coordinator.</p>
8.6	<p>Presentation of St. Christopher Centre, Games Village for Inauguration:</p> <p>Bro. Jonathan Maiyaki- the President of St. Linus Chika Conference overseeing the Centre informed the Council that the Centre is ripe for inauguration. They have been in operation for the past 3years with annual income of over N1, 000,000.00 and have severally attended Central Council meetings. They also have 21 registered active members and meets every Saturday at 6.00pm. He formally presented the members to the Council and introduced Ugonna Ezekwem as their Coordinator. The Council President thanked St. Linus for a job well done and instructed they liaise with their parish priest to fix a date for inauguration which should be beyond 2nd week of May, 2015.</p>
8.7	<p>Report of the Vincentian Family meeting: By President</p> <p>He reported that the Vincentian family meeting was held on 6th to 8th March, 2015 at DRACC Sabon Lugbe. All the arms of the Vincentian family were present. These include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The International Association of Charity (AIC) ii. The Congregation of the Mission (popularly known in Nigeria as the Vincentian Fathers and Brothers) iii. The Daughters of Charity iv. St. Vincent de Paul Society International v. Vincentian Marian Youth vi. The Association of the Miraculous Medal. <p>The Central Councils, Metro Councils and National Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul were present and souvenirs were presented to participants. A visitation to motherless babies' home in Kuje was carried out and the meeting came to an end with a Gala night.</p>
8.8	<p>Conferences' Indebtedness:</p> <p>The President informed the Council that the conferences are indebted to the Council to the tune of about 5million naira and something drastic needs to be done to address the situation. He noted that it is only Holy Trinity Maitama that is not indebted to the Council and commended them for that. A list detailing the conferences indebtedness was circulated. While some conferences accepted the amount debited to them and promised to pay others queried the amount debited against their conference and needed some clarifications. The president however informed those that needed clarifications to meet with the financial</p>

secretary with their receipts to straighten out issues and clear their debts. The end of the year was fixed as the deadline for clearing all debts.

8.9 Resolutions from the Emergency and Board Meetings of the Council:

On the 28th day of February, 2015, the leadership of the Council convened an emergency meeting to resolve some pertinent issues affecting the Council. The meeting came up with the following resolutions:

A. Ozanam House Project Committee has been reconstituted. The members of the new committee include:

B. Project Account: Project account will be reactivated to reflect the change in the signatories as new board members are now in place.

C. Submission of Annual Report: Reports should be submitted latest 31st January of each year.

D. Internal Twinning Programme: The Council has approved a twinning programme that contains the list of conferences and twined partners. The programme and process of twinning will be forwarded via emails to various conferences.

E. Training Programme: Leadership training programme will be planned for presidents and secretaries of conferences. Central council will relate with Conferences on modalities

F. Uniformity in the Identity of the Society: It was observed that conferences use different logos' and colours for the society's letter heads, T-shirts, ID Cards etc. Consequently it was agreed that:

- i. Printing of documents/materials will be regulated by the Council
- ii. The Council will also print membership ID cards and distribute to the conferences

- iii. The official colours of the society are blue, white and yellow
- iv. Central Council should henceforth be producing T-shirts which will be sold to the conferences
- v. Format of letter heading and the approved logo to be emailed to conferences to print their letter heads.
- vi. Conferences are to produce their year planner/programme of the year and submit to Central Council at the end of the preceding year.
- vii. Central Council to look at the programme to regulate visitations to communities etc. and also to distribute wealth evenly.

G. Attendance at Central Council Meetings: The Central Council is a policy making body and as such meetings of such body should be attended mostly by the Presidents and Secretaries of Conferences. However, it was agreed that henceforth, attendance will be limited to a maximum of 3 persons per conference. This will also help to reduce cost of hosting. Members are also mandated to always appear in their National or Central Council uniforms.

H. Central Council 2015 Budget: The Central Council prepared a budget of ₦1,441,200.00 and as such conferences have been levied depending on their category as stated below:

Category A	-	N64, 000.00
Category B	-	N44, 000.00
Category C	-	N25, 000.00

Conferences are expected to pay up as soon as possible to enable the Central Council function effectively.

I. Indebtedness of the Central Council to Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama: The Council agreed to pay up the N200, 000.00 borrowed from Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama during the planning of the feast day/award activity.

J. Visit to the Internally Displaced Persons Camp: The Council also decided to pay a visit to IDP camps in Kuje area of FCT on Thursday 5th March, 2015. As a result, conferences made pledges of money and materials to be used for the visitation.

8.10 Reports from Conferences:

- i. **St. Jude Conference, Zuba:** The president of the conference, Bro. Innocent Ani, appealed to the Council for financial assistance to enable them tackle

	<p>some challenges they are currently facing. The Council told him to collaborate with other conferences and also utilize the twinning mechanism.</p> <p>ii. SS Peter & Paul Conference Nyanya: The Secretary of the Conference, Bro. Bonaventure Ozojide informed the Council of their plan to introduce a centre, St. Raphael de Archangel Police Chaplaincy, Nyanya but unfortunately none of the members were present.</p> <p>iii. Request for Inauguration - St. John Catholic Church (Tunga Maje) Centre: A letter from the centre requesting for inauguration signed by the coordinator Bro. George Onyekwelu was read by the secretary of the Council. The content states that the centre started operations in 2009 as an outstation of St. Jude’s parish Zuba and can boast of 22 active and 5 auxiliary members. Their expenditure rose from N270, 000 in 2012 to about N600, 000 in 2014. The 7th day of June 2015 has been chosen, in consultation with their parish priest, for inauguration. They are seeking the approval of the Council. The Council President in his reaction faulted the procedure used by the centre to request for inauguration which is not in line with the procedure of the Society. He blamed this anomaly on St. Jude Zuba, who failed to guide a centre they nurtured in the proper direction. St. Jude’s Conference, Zuba was expected to present the centre to the Council for inauguration once they are satisfied with their performance.</p> <p>However, the Council accepted and approved the request for inauguration after confirming the claims on the letter from the President of St. Jude Zuba.</p>

9.1	<p>Report of visitation to the Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) Camp:</p> <p>The Central Council of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Abuja Archdiocese, on Thursday 5th March, 2015, paid a visit to the Internally Displaced Persons locations within the metropolis.</p> <p>The Society visited 2 locations in Kuje Area Council namely:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Abuja @ 30 Estate which has about 120 IDPs • The Kpegi Village which hosts about 200 IDPs from Chibok. <p>Gift Items such as yam, beans, soaps, mats, clothes, rice etc. were donated to the victims.</p> <p>The President of the Society, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani, while presenting the gifts, prayed God to strengthen and protect them in this time of difficulty. He equally</p>

	<p>prayed for the safe return of the Chibok girls who were kidnapped by the insurgents and for the quick return of peace in their communities.</p> <p>Some items that were remaining after the visit were donated to the Archbishop in support of his visit to the IDP's.</p>																																													
9.2	<p>St. Anthony conference:</p> <p>Ogar James Odey informed the Council of the existence of over two thousand IDPs at Waru Village.</p>																																													
9.3	<p>St. John De Baptist Pyape:</p> <p>The president, Bro. Anthony Ogbu, informed the Council of the death of one of their member Sis. Elizabeth Chukwu. All conferences were mandated to book mass for the repose of her soul.</p>
