

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SSVP) NIGERIA,
ABUJA CENTRAL COUNCIL HELD ON 23RD APRIL, 2016 AT ST. PATRICK PARISH,
KARSHI, ABUJA.**

1.0	ATTENDANCE: A total of 103 Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 9, 10 and 11.
2.0	OPENING: The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Bro. Jude Akubue of Holy Family conference, Life Camp at 10.45am.
3.0	SPIRITUAL READING: The reading with the theme “ Prayer is essential ” – taken by Sis. Nengel Felicia, president of St. Patrick conference Karshi, was taken from page 60 of the manual of the Society. Reflecting on the reading, she stressed the importance of prayer in our life. She said there is need for us to be prayerful in all our activities. “Starting our activities with prayer will grant us the spiritual strength to carry out our duties”. She further said that we should always commit demanding cases to prayer in order to have the wisdom, strength and courage to face them.
4.0	OPENING REMARKS BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT The Central Council President, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani welcomed all present and said he is impressed by the turnout despite the distance and the prevailing scarcity of fuel and this goes a long way to show that the Vincentian spirit is active in our lives. He further added that the meeting today is both crucial and strategic. Crucial in the sense that the host conference is performing below expectation and efforts are being made to support and encourage them. It is also strategic in the sense that, the host conference is twined to Holy Trinity Conference Maitama and that accounts to their ability to host this meeting. However, there should be minimum standard of operation for which conferences are not expected to fall below. He equally remarked that the board is impressed by recent observations which indicate that the conferences are learning and willing to align themselves with the rules of the society. He prayed God to give us the grace to continue to take seriously the society’s rule in order to serve the poor better.
5.0	WELCOME REMARKS BY THE HOST CONFERENCE: The president of the host conference, Sis. Felicia Nenge welcomed the Council to their conference. In her words, she said, the name of the town “Karshi” means “end” which invariably means we have all come to the end of town. She also wished the Council fruitful deliberations.

<p>6.0</p>	<p>WELCOME REMARKS BY THE PARISH PRIEST OF ST. PATRICK CATHOLIC CHURCH, KARSHI:</p> <p>The assistant parish priest, Rev. Fr. Valentine Egwuonwu, on behalf of the Parish Priest and the Parish Pastoral Council welcomed the Council to his small parish. He also encouraged Vincentians to continue on the work of charity as it is part of the spiritual works of mercy and it is demanded of every Christian to be charitable.</p> <p>He however noted that the society in his parish is struggling for finances and urged the Central Council to find a way to extend financial help to the society.</p> <p>The Council President in his response thanked the priest for the words of encouragement and advice. He further noted that Vincentians should also ask themselves of how much of their finances they are contributing to the Society and that it is very important to know that we too has to contribute financially. He however informed the priest that the society has a twinning programme which enables conferences twinned together to share ideas and assist each other financially or otherwise. St. Patrick conference is twinned to Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama.</p>

9.0	MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES
9.1	<p>Apology Letter from CKC Kubwa:</p> <p>The president informed the Council that CKC conference Kubwa has sent in a written apology letter to the Council for their hostility to the members sent to their conference to resolve the lingering crisis.</p> <p>He further said that Council has looked into it and has accepted the apology despite the fact that it took longer than necessary for the apology to be tendered. He however warned that Council will no longer tolerate this kind of behavior from any conference and will take appropriate and immediate action against such next time.</p>
9.2	<p>Late Submission of Annual Report:</p> <p>The president was pleased to report that most conferences submitted their reports before the deadline and this is highly encouraging. However, he sadly noted that Church of Assumption, Asokoro and Our Lady Queen of Nigeria, Garki defaulted and they will pay the fine of N5, 000.00 each.</p>
9.3	Inauguration of Conferences
9.31	<p><i>Inauguration of St. Augustine Sangbadi Dutse</i></p> <p>The president of the conference, Bro. Micheal Akaayar reported that the inauguration took place as scheduled on 28th February, 2016 and was highly successful. He thanked the Central council for the action and promised to live up to expectation. He equally said that for now they are not experiencing any difficulty.</p>
9.32	<p><i>Inauguration of Church of Annunciation Bazango, Kubwa</i></p> <p>The president of the conference Bro. Edejour E. Francis said the inauguration took place on the 3rd of April, 2016. He also appreciated the Central Council for the inauguration and for their support. He further requested the Central Council to grant them listening ear any time they call on them.</p>
9.33	<p><i>Inauguration of St. Benedict Efab Estate, Lokogoma on 7th February, 2016</i></p> <p>Neither the president nor any member of the conference was present to give the report.</p>

10.0	OTHER MATTERS
10.1	<p>Update on National AGM</p> <p>President informed members that the National Council has, due to some circumstances, shifted the AGM to 29th April – 1st May, 2016. The Abuja Metro still remains the host and the venue is still at DRAAC Sabon Lugbe. In that regards, conferences are expected to send in their goodwill messages at the cost of N5,000 for half page. Conferences are equally enjoined to send at least 1 person to the event. Individuals can also sponsor themselves to the event. Details of the registration fee will be made known in due course. It is a rare opportunity to witness this event as it comes once every nine years in each Metro Council.</p>
10.2	<p>2015 Annual Report and Account</p> <p>The president informed the Council that the 2015 annual report and account has been prepared and ready to be submitted to the Archbishop and the Spiritual Adviser. This is in line with the board’s decision to be open and transparent in its activities. The report will equally be circulated to all conference presidents and board members.</p>
11.0	REPORTS FROM CONFERENCES:
11.1	<p>St. Joseph Conference, Gwagwa</p> <p>The secretary of the conference, Bro. Eugene Bucham, reported that they were not able to conduct the Easter sharing because of the numerous cases they are handling. The president of the council in his response told them that having numerous cases is not an excuse and that all conferences at some points do have some challenge of numerous cases. They should have approached their twinned conference for assistance.</p>
11.2	<p>SS Peter & Paul Conference, Nyanya:</p> <p>The immediate past president of the conference, Bro. Bonaventure Nwokpor, informed the Council that some time ago, they had election in their conference that saw to the emergence of Bro. Amaco Andrew as the new president. He went ahead and introduced the new president. The new secretary, unfortunately, was unavoidably absent.</p>
11.3	<p>Church of the Archangel Conference, Durunmi:</p> <p>A member of the conference present informed the Council that the newly elected president is absent from today’s meeting because she is writing exams and as such could not be introduced to the Council</p>
11.4	<p>St. John Conference, Mpape:</p> <p>Bro. Agomuo, a member of St. John conference brought to the notice of the Council of the challenge being presently faced by them. In his words he said that they have some clients who are accommodated in an uncompleted building exposing them to sicknesses. He then sought to know if they can get accommodation for them.</p>

	<p>The Council reminded him that no act of charity is alien to the society. As long as they have conducted thorough investigation and weighed the merits and demerits of assistance based on the circumstances prevalent in our society. They can assist within the limits of their resources.</p>
11.5	<p>St. Peter Claver Conference, University of Abuja.</p> <p>The president of the St. Paul Gwagwalada, Bro. I. Idemeter, informed the Council that on 25th February, 2016, an election was conducted for St. Peter Claver conference that saw to the emergence of Sis. Joan Okoro as president. She is a 400-level law student of the institution. He equally reported that they are doing fine.</p>
11.6	<p>St. Joseph Centre Zone 7 Lugbe:</p> <p>The Coordinator of St. Joseph Centre Zone 7 Lugbe, Sis. Onyeka Maureen, informed the Council that after consultations with their parish priest and their mother conference, St. Martin, Lugbe, 29th of May, 2016 has been chosen as the day for their inauguration during the 9.00am mass. The Council president accepted the date and urged all conferences to be present for the inauguration.</p>
11.7	<p>St. Rita Center, Ndako:</p> <p>The vice president of St. Anthony Kabusa, Bro. Johnson Akubo, informed the Council that St. Rita centre they have been nurturing is ripe for inauguration. He then requested that they be inaugurated on the 19th day of June, 2016 during the 8.30am mass. The Council ratified the inauguration and the president urged all Vincentians to be available on that day.</p>
11.8	<p>Metro Meeting Report:</p> <p>The president reported that the Council attended the last Metro Council meeting held in Lokoja on 12th -14th March, 2016. The Council was represented by himself, the Secretary and Treasurer. Highlight of the meeting include the presentation of annual reports by all the central councils within the Abuja metro council and the planning of the oncoming National AGM being hosted by Abuja Metro Council.</p> <p>In the annual report presented by the Abuja Central Council, there was a substantial increase in the income over last year which is as a result of the capturing of the annual report of un-inaugurated conferences.</p> <p>He further reported that the metro president stressed the need for Central Councils to put more effort in inaugurating viable conferences and getting them aggregated as more members and conferences attracts recognition of the National Council at the International Council. He then urged conferences to keep on monitoring and following up un-inaugurated conferences under their care and prayed that their services to the poor will not go unrewarded.</p> <p>He finally said that the meeting was indeed a successful one.</p>

11.9	<p>Archbishops Visit to Kuje Prison:</p> <p>The president reported that on Saturday 5th March, 2016, the Council accompanied the Archbishop, His Eminence, John Cardinal Onaiyekan, to Kuje Prison for the opening of the door of God’s Mercy to mark the Jubilee Year of Mercy . This is in response to the invitation extended to the society by the spiritual adviser, Rev. Fr. Sebastian Musa to be part of the visit. The Council was represented by himself and the secretary and a donation of N50, 000.00 was made on behalf of the Society to complement the archbishops’ donation to the inmates of the prison.</p>
11.10	<p>Central Council Training</p> <p>The president announced that the training earlier scheduled to hold on 7th May, 2016 has been shifted. The training will now hold on 14th May, 2016 at same time and venue. The shift in date is to enable the Council to have at least 1 week rest after hosting the AGM.</p> <p>He also said that the training, which is structured so that participants will be equipped to do great exploits for the society, is compulsory for all conferences and un-inaugurated conferences.</p> <p>Conferences are to come with 6 members and register with N5,0000 while un-inaugurated ones are to come with 4 members for a fee of N3,000. Those absent will be queried and must pay the registration fee. And attendance will also form part of assessment for un-inaugurated conferences.</p>
12.0	<p>AOB</p>
12.1	<p>Ozanam House Project Contribution:</p> <p>The president of the Council informed members that one Mr. Ikenna Chukwueke from Holy Trinity Maitama fulfilled his pledge of 250,000.00 towards the Ozanam House project. A letter of appreciation will be sent to him. He equally encouraged conferences to talk to their benefactors in respect of contributions to the project and that very soon the project account will be sent to all conferences.</p>
12.2	<p>Awareness Campaign to St. Raphael Garki:</p> <p>The president of Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Conference, Garki, Bro. Uche Ofia informed the Council that due to the oncoming AGM, the awareness campaign planned for the St. Raphael conference in collaboration with other neighboring conferences has been rescheduled to next Sunday, 8th May, 2016.</p> <p>However, the president of the Council opined that they can still go ahead with the earlier scheduled date(1st May, 2016) as the date is the departure date for the AGM and conferences will not be needed that day.</p>
12.3	<p>Template for Twinning Report:</p> <p>The templates for writing twinning report and project completion report will be forwarded to the email addresses of conferences. The new aggregation forms and</p>

	<p>explanatory notes will also be forwarded to the emails of conferences that are yet to be aggregated. The forms are to be filed and returned to the secretariat.</p>
12.4	<p>Our Lady Queen of Peace Utako</p> <p>A member of the conference sought to know what they can do to clients whom after investigations, conference decided to send them home to their villages but they refuse and demands for empowerment.</p> <p>The Council president responded by saying that conferences should always learn to take a decision and stand by their decision. Such clients can equally be counseled but you should not force a decision on the client.</p>
12.5	<p>Youth Report:</p>
12.51	<p><i>The Community Visitation:</i></p> <p>Central Council youth coordinator, Bro. Fidelis Akomaye, informed the Council of the on-coming visitation to Shenegu Community in Zuba scheduled to hold on the 7th of May, 2016. He appealed for financial assistance from conference presidents and donation of food items such as rice beans, condiments and washing detergents to sponsor their youth for this visit. They will be meeting at Our Lady Queen of Nigeria at 8.00am and depart at 9.00am.</p>
12.52	<p><i>Youth Training:</i></p> <p>The youth coordinator equally announced that their training will be coming up on 12th June, 2016. Conferences are expected to come with 5 delegates and will pay a registration fee of 3,000.00. The venue of the training will be Our Lady Queen of Nigeria, Pro Cathedral, Garki and time is 9.00am. He urged conference presidents to make sure of their youths participation.</p> <p>The president of the Council in his response assured of his support towards the training and other activities of the youth, and urged the conferences to equally lend their support and assist the youth. The training is planned to be bi-annual and they need to be equipped to take over the leadership of the society in future. He equally urged Our Lady Queen of Nigeria to take care of the youth during the training.</p>
12.6	<p>Observations from Sis. Joan Okoro</p> <p>The president of St. Clavers conference observed that the minutes of the meeting was not signed by the secretary and president and also members are not given ample time to express themselves when opportunity is granted.</p> <p>She further observed that there is seeming unpreparedness by the executives which shows itself on the level of consultations that goes on whenever some issues demanding immediate answers are raised.</p> <p>Responding to these observations the president of the Council, said that the minutes of the meeting will be signed after adoption. He also said that there is need for people giving opportunity to talk to go straight to the point and because time is of the</p>

essence people may not be given all the time they need to express themselves. He equally responded to the observed consultations that go on within the executives saying that board meetings are always being held before the meeting; however there are issues that may be thrown up at the meeting that will demand consultations before taking a stand to avoid dishing out wrong information capable of misleading members.

12.7 Remarks/Response from The Patron

The patron of the Society, Sir. G Ebhojie, in his remarks appreciated the attendance at the meeting saying that barring the circumstances prevailing in our society, the attendance was good. He however advised that members should call the leadership for valid apologies for absence.

He also responded to some issues raised in the course of the meeting such as:

i. Attending to Clients and Accommodation:

He said that it is not the duty of members to impress on clients to go home to their villages unless the client wants to go. Cases are to be objectively and dispassionately looked at and handled accordingly within its merits. If a client deserves to be assisted with accommodation, after dispassionately and objectively looked at, nothing stops the conference from doing so if it is within their reach.

ii. Consultations by the board in the course of meeting:

Also responding to the issue raised by the president of St. Peter Claver University of Abuja on the perceived/observed consultations by the board before answering some questions, he said that nobody knows it all hence the need to confer before addressing the general house to avoid misleading people.
