

**Minutes of the Meeting of the Society of St. Vincent De Paul (SSVP) Abuja Central Council  
Held on 28<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 at Church of Annunciation ,Arab Road Kubwa.**

1.0	<p><b>Attendance</b> A total of 164 Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 13, 14 &amp; 15.</p>
2.0	<p><b>Opening</b> The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Bro. Ignatius M. Idemeter of St. Paul Conference, Gwagwalada.</p>
3.0	<p><b>Spiritual Reading</b> The reading with the theme “Even the Best” from page 79 of the new Manual of the Society was read by Bro.Charles Nwachukwu, a special board member. Reflecting on the reading, he noted that we ought to care for the needy without tampering with money given to us. He further noted that we must be careful in utilizing the finances entrusted unto us for the care of the needy amongst us.</p> <p>In his contribution to the topic, Bro. Jude Akubue also remarked that apart from the financial resources, other materials and food items etc. given to the Vincentians should not be misused; it has to get to the needy.</p> <p>Finally in her contribution, the Central Council President, Sis. Joy Ohiagu also added that any property given to us should not be hoarded or taken home.</p>
4.0	<p><b>Opening Remarks By The Council President.</b> The Council President welcomed the conference presidents and members present and thanked God who guided all safely to the venue of the meeting. She thanked all those who came from as far as Gwagwalada, Bwari etc. inspite of the location of the meeting.</p>
5.0	<p><b>Welcome Remarks by the Parish Priest of Church of Annunciation, Arab Road, Kubwa.</b> In his welcome remarks, Bro. Paul Okhiria, the Parish Pastoral Council Vice Chairman, representing the parish priest, welcomed the Council and acknowledged the good work of the Society in the parish. He equally extended the best wishes from the parish priest, whom he said is a Vincentian, to the Council and also regretted his unavoidable absence. He then thanked all present and wished the Central Council a happy deliberation and safe trip back to their various homes.</p>
6.0	<p><b>Welcome Remark by the President of the Host Conference.</b> The Conference President, Bro. Paul Ogbu Anoke, on behalf of his conference members, parishioners and the residents welcomed the Council to his conference. He implored the Council to accept their level of hospitality then wished the Council successful deliberations.</p>

9.0	<p><b>Matters Arising from the Minutes.</b></p>
9.1	<p><b>Update on the Election of President of St. Linus Conference, Chika:</b></p> <p>Bro. John Okoro reported that election was held two (2) weeks ago. He further reported that he got a report that the Parish Priest said he will not accept the person that was elected because he is not a communicant.</p> <p>Responding to the report, the Council president directed Bro. Daniel Kolo to go and conduct a fresh election for the Conference.</p> <p>The Council also resolved that henceforth a non-communicant should not be nominated to stand for election in the Society.</p>
9.2	<p><b>Update on the Awareness Campaign at 12 Apostles Conference.</b></p> <p>Bro. John Okoro reported that the awareness campaign was carried out and a meeting was held afterwards where the presidents and secretaries of the Garki Zone conferences were in attendance.</p> <p>He also reported that 98 persons indicated interest to be members of the Society amongst which 37 are full members and 53 are benefactors while 8 are members/benefactors. He also added that work is in progress.</p> <p>The Central Council President thanked the said Garki monitoring team should follow up on the conference. All should be carried along.</p>
9.3	<p><b>Update on Ozanam House Project:</b></p> <p>The Vice President of the Central Council, Sis. Agatha Irabor, and also a member of the Ozanam House Project Committee, reported that Sir. Emmanuel Ajewole, the Chairman of the Committee, is indisposed. However, she informed the Council that the TDP is already signed.</p>
9.4	<p><b>Report of the Hosting of Abuja Metro Council Meeting and the International President General:</b></p> <p>At the Council meeting held in November, 2016, a planning committee was officially constituted to plan and execute the dual events of hosting the 47<sup>th</sup> Abuja Metro Council meeting and planning for the visit of the International President General, Bro. Renato Lima De Oliveira. While the former was slated to hold from 9<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, the later was to hold from 24<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. <p><b>9.41</b></p>	<p><b>Hosting of the Metro Council Meeting</b></p> <p>On the 9<sup>th</sup> of Feb. 2018, delegates from the Metro Council arrived Abuja for the 47<sup>th</sup> meeting of the SSVP Abuja Metropolitan Council which took place at Sada Cruz Hotel, Jikwoyi.</p> <p>The Metro Council paid a courtesy visit to His Eminence, who was unavoidably absent but in his stead, Rev. Fr. Chris Bologo received the Council. The Council also paid a courtesy visit to the parish priest of the host parish, St. Kevin Jikwoyi.</p> <p>The next day of the event, 10<sup>th</sup> February, witnessed a presentation of the Keynote Address by His Eminence, John Cardinal Onaiyekan, who was represented by Rev. Fr. Nwakpuda.</p> <p>The day also witnessed a Paper Presentation: <b><i>“Serving the Poor in our Communities: The Essence and Benefits”</i></b> by Rev. Fr. Kingsley Ferdinand (Associate Priest, St. Martin Parish, Lugbe) and Annual Reports presentations by the Central Councils.</p> <p>The Abuja Central Council also received Aggregation Certificates for 26 of its conferences. The activity of the day ended up with Gala Night where members wined and dined in a lighter mood.</p> <p>The committee is extremely grateful to the conferences of St. Kevin and St. Ephraim, all in Jikwoyi for their support. The conferences not only provided the human resources that enabled efficient logistics, they also sponsored the gala night and the light refreshments taken during the course of the meeting.</p> <p>The Committee is equally grateful to the conferences of Holy Trinity, Maitama and Our Lady Queen of Nigeria Conference, Garki for releasing their buses for the movement of men and materials.</p> <p>In attendance at the meeting were delegates from Abuja, Lafia, Lokoja, Gboko, Markudi, Idah, Katsina Ala Central Councils as well as Vincentians from the various conferences in Abuja Central Council.</p>
<p><b>9.42</b></p>	<p><b>Hosting of the International President, Bro. Renato Lima De Oliveira</b></p> <p>On the 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, the International and National Officers arrived Abuja and were checked in to their rooms at the Pope John Paul II Centre. The International President, Bro. Renato De Oliveira arrived Abuja Airport at about 11.00pm and was welcomed and received by the International and National Officers who were already at the Airport expecting him. They equally accompanied him to the hotel, where he was lodged for the period of his stay.</p> <p>On the 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of the visit, Bro. Renato and all Vincentians attended mass at the Cathedral, where he was given an opportunity to address the congregation and he informed them of his mission in Nigeria and thanked both the clergy and the laity for their support and encouragement to the Society.</p> <p>After the mass, due to the absence of His Eminence, and the Council was unable to secure either the Auxiliary Bishop or the Vicar to receive the International President on courtesy visit, despite all efforts made, a courtesy visit to the Cathedral Administrator, Rev. Fr. Jude Nwigwe, later took place.</p> <p>Thereafter, the International President and all officers and members proceeded to the Pope John Paul II Parish, for the commissioning and opening of the National Council temporary office as well as a meeting of Bro. Renato with all Vincentians.</p> <p>The Parish Priest, Rev. Fr. Christopher Inegbenoghu offered prayers, blessed and dedicated the office to God and was thereafter commissioned by the International President.</p> <p>The National President in his speech at the meeting welcomed the International president, intimating him on the activities of the Council; the achievements, prospects and challenges. In his remarks during the interactive the International President introduced himself as a 47-year-old journalist who works for the Communication Commission of his Country, Brazil. He is married with two (2) children.</p>

He belongs to the Our Lady of Fatima conference, and attends his conference meetings regularly and also performs duties as assigned by his conference president.

After the interactive session where questions were asked and answered by the International officer, the youth members of the conference of St. John conference, Zuba entertained the audience with traditional dances and drama presentation to the admiration of the International President who later made a donation of 50 Euro to the Conference. The activity of the day ended with the presentation of Aggregation Certificates to the presidents of some conferences in Abuja Central Council.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the Visit started with a visit to Kuje Prison where the International President met and interacted with the inmates, comforting them with songs and giving them words of encouragement. Several gift items were also presented to the inmates.

This was closely followed by the meeting of the Vincentian Family with the International president at SS Simon & Jude Minor Seminary, Kuje. At the meeting, the coordinator of the family in Abuja, Rev. Fr. Victor Nyoroh CM, welcomed the president on behalf of the Vincentian Family and the various arms of the family took turns to introduce themselves.

The International president in his address dwelt on the need for closer collaboration of the various arms of the family.

After the meeting, the president and all officers visited 2 adoptees within the jurisdiction of OLQM Conference, Sabon Lugbe where he interacted with them through comforting words and songs and also presented them with gift items. He equally made a donation of 100USD to the conference of OLQM to aid them in taking care of the adoptees.

Afterwards, the entourage proceeded to the conference of Holy Family, Life Camp for a meeting with the conference. At the conference, the president was received by the Parish priest, where he thanked the priest for his support to the work of the conference in his parish. The president also addressed the conference and also interacted with our masters present at the conference. The conference president, on behalf of the conference, presented a gift to the International President which he received with gladness and thanks.

<p><b>9.9</b></p>	<p><b>Election at St. Raphael Police Chaplaincy, Garki</b></p> <p>On the 3rd of March, election was held at Police Chaplaincy, Garki which saw the Secretary of the Conference, Bro Samson Agbo elected as president in absentia.</p> <p>Responding to the report, Bro C. Nwachukwu said that they broke the rule, one is not elected in absentia and that next time such election will not stand.</p> <p>The Central Council President Sis Joy Ohiagu also responded by saying that it will not be tolerated again. No member is permitted to be voted in absentia.</p>
<p><b>9.10</b></p>	<p><b>Update on Annual Report Submission and Payment of Annual Dues.</b></p> <p>The Council President said that the following conferences are yet to submit their annual reports: St. Anthony Jabi, Holy Rosary Wuse, Church of Assumption, Asokoro, St. Luke Kubwa, 12 Apostles, St Jude Zuba, St. Joseph Gwagwa, Holy Ghost Saburi, St. Mathew Karimu, Church of the Archangel Durumi, St. Augustine, Zapagi and Church of Annunciation Arab Road.</p> <p>These conferences, she said, have failed to submit their annual reports and also did not pay their annual dues. Consequently, they will pay a fine of ₦5, 000.00 each; and the money should not be from conference purse, but from each president’s personal purse.</p> <p>She also commended St Benedict Lokogoma for giving good report and for their early submission. She gave them kudos for a job well done.</p> <p>St Augustine’s president remarked that he asked his Vice to submit their report because he has been away for a long time and only two members complied in payment of dues. The Council advised him to put his house in order.</p> <p>Bro. C. Nwachukwu pleaded that the Council should take it easy with Holy Rosary Conference Wuse due to the fact that they are not finding thing easy with the present Parish Priest..</p> <p>The Council president also remarked that if any conference is confused on how to write a good annual report, another opportunity will be there during the Council bi-annual training coming up in</p>

	<p>2 weeks-time. Members from all conferences should send their representatives.</p> <p>She also noted that some conferences submitted their report but without annual dues, she advised all to pay up either in full payment or by installments.</p>
9.11	<p><b>Update on the Planned Inauguration of St. Pius X Conference, Gbagalape &amp; St. Ephraim Conference Jikwoyi.</b></p> <p>St. Pius X Conference, Gbagalape which was nurtured by SS Peter &amp; Paul Conference, Nyanya will be inaugurated as scheduled on the 29th July, 2018 at 9.00am mass. The coordinator of the conference is Bro. Titus Gyegwe.</p> <p>On the other hand, St. Ephraim Conference, Jikwoyi which was nurtured by St Kevin Conference, Jikwoyi is also to be inaugurated on 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 at 8.30am mass. The coordinator is Bro. Yakubu.</p> <p>Conferences are expected to send representatives to the inauguration.</p>
10.0	<b>OTHER MATTERS</b>
10.1	<p><b>Central Council Training:</b></p> <p>The Council President said Central Council training will be coming up on 12<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 at Holy Cross Conference, Gwarimpa at 9:00am. Consequently, inaugurated conferences are to send in 5 members with the sum of ₦5,000.00 (Five Thousand Naira only) while non-inaugurated conferences are to send 4 members with the sum of ₦3,000.00 (Three Thousand Naira only). She enjoined all conferences to see it as a duty to participate in the training.</p>
10.2	<p><b>Report on Burial of Late Bro. Paschal Ahizih</b></p> <p>It would be recalled that Abuja central Council lost a Patron Bro. Pascal Ahizih on 21 February, 2018. One minute silence was observed in his memory.</p> <p>He was buried on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. The Council was well represented during the burial as two buses conveyed members to his home town in Imo State. During the burial, a white cloth with the logo of the Society was placed on the casket. The burial was successful and the delegates had a hitch-free journey.</p> <p>The Council spent N20, 000.00 on fuel and N40, 000.00 produce copies of banner bearing the Society's logo. It was also reported that N780, 000 and 100 dollars was contributed when bro Paschal was ill. Part of the money was spent on drugs at the hospital, and during his burial.</p> <p>The remaining sum of N68, 800 and 100 dollars will be given to his family. It was resolved that in the event of the death of a member of the society, Council will visit the family, celebrate mass with them and present a logo of the society.</p>
10.3	<p><b>Twinning &amp; Aggregation.</b></p> <p>Bro. Emma Nnaemeka, the Twinning &amp; Aggregation Officer, presented a twinning chart to the Council and remarked that the Twinning was done based on the strength of the grades [A, B, C] conferences and the Twinning does not necessarily mean, collection of money from twinned conference. It might be for the whole purpose of exchange of ideas, collaborations etc.</p> <p>He further informed the Council that in the twinning arrangement, 8 grade A conferences were twinned with 2 Conferences while 1 grade A conference got 3 conferences. He added that grades A and B conferences are the giving conferences while grade C conferences are the receivers.</p> <p>After few comments from members of the Council, some changes were made to the twinning chart presented to reflect the resolutions made by the Council.</p> <p>The twinning arrangement is as detailed below:</p>
