

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SSVP) NIGERIA,
ABUJA CENTRAL COUNCIL HELD ON 30TH JANUARY, 2016 AT HOLY FAMILY PARISH,
LIFE CAMP, ABUJA.**

1.0	<p>ATTENDANCE:</p> <p>A total of 121 Vincentians was in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 9, 10, and 11.</p>
2.0	<p>OPENING:</p> <p>The meeting started with an opening prayer said by Bro. Magnus Imuse, the President of St. Theresa conference, Bwari at 11.00am.</p>
3.0	<p>SPIRITUAL READING:</p> <p>The reading with the theme “Prayer must be linked with our daily life” – culled from the talk by St. Vincent to his community was read by Bro. Makava Daniel of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Conference Sabon Lugbe and was taken from page 60 of the manual of the Society. Reflecting on the reading, he said that just as we need food to nourish our body so also we need prayers to nourish our soul. Without prayers in our activities, we can experience a disastrous outcome. We should always ask God to take charge of what we do by calling on Him to lead us in our activities as Vincentians. He equally urged all to take it as a rule to pray always in and out of season.</p>
4.0	<p>OPENING REMARKS BY THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT</p> <p>The Central Council President, Bro. Chibuzor Ezeani welcomed all present and wished all a Happy New Year. He thanked the board members for their support, contributions and making themselves available always and urged them to continue in this tempo. He equally thanked the spiritual adviser for being with us at every meeting.</p> <p>Furthermore, he enjoined Vincentians to avail themselves of every opportunity to learn more about the society to avoid making mistakes. He urged them to make themselves available during trainings and this will help to improve our attitude towards the society.</p> <p>Conjuring ideas on your own against the rules of the Society leads to mistakes. He urged members especially the leaders to always keep to the rules, attend trainings, consult the higher authority on any issue and this will help you to be a better leader.</p>
5.0	<p>WELCOME REMARKS BY THE HOST CONFERENCE:</p> <p>The president of the host conference was unavoidably absent but was represented by the Financial Secretary, Sis. Ozoemena Fidelia. She welcomed the Council to Holy</p>

	Family Parish and wished the Council fruitful deliberations.
6.0	<p>WELCOME REMARKS BY THE PARISH PRIEST OF HOLY FAMILY CATHOLIC CHURCH:</p> <p>The assistant parish priest, Rev. Fr. Habib Akpata, on behalf of the Parish Priest and the Parish Pastoral Council welcomed the Council to his parish and enjoined Vincentians to enjoy their presence in Holy Family. He equally prayed the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph guide the Society in all her activities.</p>
7.0	<p>READING, OBSERVATION, AMENDMENT AND ADOPTION OF MINUTES:</p> <p>The minutes of the previous meeting held at St. St. Luke Conference, Kubwa on 5th December, 2015 were studied by all present and no observations/corrections were made.</p> <p>In the absence of corrections and observations, a motion for the adoption of the minutes was moved by Bro. Emmanuel Agada of St. Charles Lwanga Conference, Apo and seconded by Ugoh Patricia Nnenna of St. Donald Conference, Karu.</p>
8.0	<p>APOLOGIES:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Christopher Chukwu of St. Chistopher Conference, Games Village • Sir. G Ebhojie of OLQM conference Sabon Lugbe • Cyprain Ebiziem of All Saints Conference, Dutse Maria
9.0	MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES
9.1	<p>Report on the Official Reception of Sacred Heart Center, Airport:</p> <p>The president informed the Council it has been decided that the conference will be received officially by the Central Council in this meeting and he then called the president and members of the conference to come forward for the reception. The spiritual adviser then formally received the conference guided by the stipulations of the manual of the Society.</p>
9.2	<p>Apology Letter from CKC Kubwa:</p> <p>The president reminded the Council of the decision by the board requiring CKC Kubwa to tender in writing an apology letter to the Council for their hostility to the members sent to their conference to resolve the lingering crisis. He said that the Council has not received any apology letter, he then called the president of CKC Kubwa to explain why they have not done as ordered.</p> <p>In her explanations, Sis. Oby Adoro, said that she was not present at the last central council meeting and nobody briefed her on the outcome of this issue and as such she appealed to be guided.</p>

	At this juncture, various speakers on this issue admonished her on her attitude which fell short of a Vincentian. The Council president stressed the need for Vincentians to play by the rules. He gave her 1 month to make the apology letter available.
9.3	<p>Annual Report Submission:</p> <p>The president called on conference presidents to submit their annual reports as agreed with their annual dues. He equally conveyed the decision of the board that Conferences that failed to submit their report in 2 weeks' time will pay a fine of N5,000.00</p>
9.4	<p>St. Joseph Gwagwa; Awareness Campaign</p> <p>Bro. Izuchukwu Nwaeze reported that the awareness campaign took place as scheduled on 6th December, 2015 at 6am and 8am masses. It was a huge success. He thanked the Council for their support and encouragement.</p>
9.5	<p>Inauguration of Conferences:</p> <p>In response to the request for Inauguration of some Centre's by their mother conferences, having found them worthy for it, the Council approved for inauguration the following centres:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. St. Benedict Efab Estate, Lokogoma - 7th February, 2016 ii. St. Augustine Centre Sangbadi Dutse – 28th February, 2016 iii. Church of Annunciation – 3rd April, 2016(tentative) <p>The president urged members to attend en masse for the inauguration of these centres.</p>
10.0	OTHER MATTERS
10.1	<p>2015 Financial Account</p> <p>The president informed the Council that the Central Council accounts is almost ready but needs to resolve some payment issues with conferences. However, from the balance of the account, the Council intends crediting the Ozanam House Project account with N1, 000,000.00. N104, 000.00 will be remitted to FAMVIN and this represents pledges made at the joint feast celebration in which the Council pledged 20,000 while some members pledged a total of N84, 000.00.</p> <p>Consequently, conferences are given 2 weeks to meet with the financial secretary to resolve their accounts while those that made pledges are implored to redeem it soonest. This will enable the Council to finalize the 2015 account and present it in the next Council meeting.</p>
10.2	Conferences Indebtedness:

	<p>President informed members that some conferences still owe huge sums of money to the Council and as such hampering the Councils progress. It was resolved at the board meeting of the Council that a deadline of end of march, 2016 and end of year 2016 be given for Category A & B conferences respectively to offset their debts.</p>
10.3	<p>Programme of the Year:</p> <p>The president informed the conference presidents that it is now required of them to draw up their yearly programme and submit same to the Council and as well, made it known to all conference members. However, the programme of the year should not clash with the Councils' programme.</p>
10.4	<p>Conferences Jurisdiction:</p> <p>The president stressed on the need for conferences to have clear cut jurisdiction to avoid conflicts in handling of clients. It has been observed that some clients take advantage of this situation to move from one conference to another.</p>
10.5	<p>National AGM</p> <p>President informed members that the National Council has chosen Abuja Metro Council to host its next meeting coming up on the 14th to 17th April, 2016 at DRAAC Sabon Lugbe. In that regards, Bro. Paschal Ahizih was chosen as the Chairman of the organizing committee. Other members of the committee include: Augustine Inoh (Accommodation), Joy Ohiagu(Entertainment), Albert Nzekwu(Programmes/Publicity). He equally said that more members will be drafted to join the committee in due course and any member is called to work with the committee should kindly oblige.</p>
11.0	<p>REPORTS FROM CONFERENCES:</p>
11.1	<p>Reports of death of members, clients and benefactors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. St. JohnMary Vianney Conference, Kubwa: Nnenna Obeta – Client ii. St. Luke Conference Kubwa: Sis. Uchechi Fidelis – Client iii. St. Luke Conference Kubwa: Mr. Innocent Nwachukwu – Benefactor iv. St. Christopher Games Village: Sir. Budi Iwaleko - Benefactor v. Sebastian Musa led the Council in saying the resurrection prayer on behalf of the faithful departed. Thereafter the president urged conferences</p>

	to book masses for the repose of their souls.
11.2	<p>Cathedral of 12 Apostles Conference:</p> <p>The president of the conference, Bro. Taiwo Patrick, informed the Council some conferences did not stick to the approved time of 10.00am for start of sharing during the Christmas period. And as such they witnessed an unusual surge in their conference. Imagine a situation where clients came to their conference on a bus. Urged all conferences to comply with the set time to avoid the situation whereby clients move from one conference to another.</p>
11.3	<p>St. John de Beloved Conference Tunga Mage:</p> <p>The president of the conference, Bro. George Onyekwelu, informed the Council of the setting up of Society of St Vincent de Paul in St. Patrick, a new outstation within their jurisdiction. They have started to nurture them and will report progress from time to time.</p>
11.4	<p>St. Martin Conference, Lugbe:</p> <p>The president of St. Martin Conference Lugbe, Bro. Fidelis Molokwu, reported that the issue surrounding the inauguration of St. Joseph Centre Zone 7 Lugbe, as reported in the previous Central Council meeting has be sorted out. He has picked 17th April or 8th May, 2016, as the proposed date for inauguration subject to Councils approval. However, the president informed him that the said dates will not be feasible as they are clashing with some programmes of the Council. He however proposed 29th May or 5th June, 2016 for inauguration of the centre, subject to the approval of the parish priest.</p>
11.5	<p>SS Peter & Paul Conference Nyanya:</p> <p>The immediate past president of the Conference Bro. Bonaventure Nwokpor, informed the Council that election took place in his conference which saw the emergence of Bro. Amako Andrew as the new president of the conference. He equally apologized to the Council of the inability of the new president to be present at the meeting for introduction. The new president is unavoidably absent.</p> <p>Furthermore, he brought to the knowledge of the Council the activities of the coordinator of St. Pius Gbagalape, Bro. Geoffrey Akiga, who he said that despite the level of membership, runs the society alone and goes about to some conferences soliciting for funds on behalf of the society without consultation with the mother conference. He also noted that he discussed the issue with the parish priest of St. Pius and they agreed that the present board be dissolved and reconstituted. And that had</p>

	<p>been done and as such Geofferey Akiga is no longer the coordinator of St. Pius Gbagalape.</p> <p>He equally brought to the knowledge of the Council, the situation report of two(2) other conferences being nurtured by them namely: St. Raphael Police Chaplaincy, Nyanya and St. Augustine Centre Angwandadi. He said that while the former is making great progress and will soon be presented for inauguration, the latter is still shaky despite the fact that they have existed for a long time but in a very remote area.</p>
<p>11.6</p>	<p>St. Luke Conference, Kubwa:</p> <p>The president of the conference, Bro. Jude Iwuagwu, intimated the Council of the situation of St. Michael Centre Kagini, which they have nurtured for 4 years yet they failed to grow. Presently they can boast of only 3 members. He sought to know if they can be inaugurated.</p> <p>Responding to this issue, the Council president told him that a 3-man conference is not viable and it is not a must to have a conference in a parish. However, he noted, that there must be a problem hampering the growth of the centre and the mother conference needs to critically study the problem and proffer a solution.</p>
<p>11.7</p>	<p>Sacred Heart, Gwagwalada:</p> <p>The Conference President, Ezeigwe Mathew, brought to the knowledge of the Council of a new Centre they are nurturing in St. Catherine Catholic Church Giri-Gwagwalada. The Centre has 11 members and has Bro. Hyacinth Onyeibe Eze as the Coordinator</p>

<p>12.1</p>	<p>Comments by Parish Priest of Holy Family Parish</p> <p>The Parish Priest of Holy Family, Rev.Fr. Anthony Olaniyan, and also the Chairperson of the Year of Mercy in the archdiocese, urged the Society of St. Vincent de Paul to help in realizing the vision of Pope Francis in this Year of Mercy. He enjoined the Society to carry the idea in all they do.</p> <p>He equally informed the Council that as part of the programmes lined up in this Year of Mercy, the Archbishop, John Cardinal Olorunfemi Onaiyekan, on the 5th of March, 2016, will be visiting Kuje Prison. In this visit, some prisoners are expected to be released, exam fees of some prisoners will be paid and also those with medical challenges will be attended to. Details of this visit will be communicated to all parishes in due course.</p> <p>Finally, he prayed God to bless us in our apostolate.</p>
