

**Minutes of the Meeting of the International Confederation of the Society of St. Vincent De Paul (SSVP), Abuja Central Council Held at Our Lady of Fatima, Conference, Karomajigi on 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.**

1.0	<p><b>Attendance</b> A total of Two Hundred and Sixty-Nine (269) Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 11, 12, 13, 14 and 16.</p>
2.0	<p><b>Opening</b> The meeting started at 11.20am. The opening prayer and spiritual reading were skipped because a Holy Mass for the Society which began at 10:00am preceded the meeting.</p>
3.0	<p><b>Opening Remarks by the Council President:</b> The Council President thanked God for the gift of life, the grace to witness every new day and for Vincentians to gather again for a meeting. He added that we should be mindful because every day that passes takes us closer to our own graves so we must focus on the love of God and of neighbor as Jesus Christ instructed. He further stated that every minute of our lives is an opportunity to do the right thing and make amends for any wrong especially while we serve the poor.</p> <p>In conclusion, he prayed to God to grant a successful meeting with meaningful deliberation and urged all members present to be attentive.</p>
4.0	<p><b>Welcome Remarks by the Host Conference President:</b> Bro. Jude Aladi, the host Conference President welcomed all Vincentians in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. He noted that the Conference has been in existence for three (3) years and by the special grace of God, they have been able to carry out the work of the poor especially due to the peculiarity of their location. He added that his Conference is grateful for the opportunity to host the meeting and prayed that God continues to help the conference grow in strength. He finally prayed that God to grant the Council fruitful deliberations throughout the meeting.</p>

5.1	<p><b>Reading of Minutes, Observations, Corrections and Amendments:</b> The minutes of the previous meeting held at St. Agnes Conference, Wuye on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 was studied by all present and the following observations/corrections were made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Page 2(6.0): Bro. Isidore Udenko the President of St. Agnes, Wuye noted that the name of their Parish Priest is Fr. Richard Gberikon and not <i>Fr. Peter Belikan</i> as recorded.</li> <li>ii. Page 5(9.10, iii): Bro. Ipenyi Sylvester noted that in the list of Conference executives for Holy Cross Gwarimpa, item 7 was wrongly spelt as '<i>Olohire Abulu</i>' instead of '<i>Olotire Abutu</i>' and item 11 was wrongly spelt as '<i>Donnie Ono</i>' instead of '<i>Dominic Ono</i>'.</li> <li>iii. Page 6(9.10, vii): Bro Gerald Ajoku noted that it was himself and Bro. Marcel Anyatonwu that conducted the election at Church of Annunciation, Arab road and not Bro. Marcel alone as reported.</li> </ul>

7.0	<p><b>Matters Arising from the Minutes:</b></p>
7.1	<p><b>Update on the location of 'Old Karchi' Settlement under Gwagwalada Area Council:</b> Bro. Kola Olumolu, the President of St. Paul's Conference, Gwagwalada reported that the location and urgent need in the settlement had been identified which is to provide fifty (50) seats for the school there and it amounts to ₦500,000 at ₦10,000 each. He further stated that upon receiving the mandate to spearhead the project, a WhatsApp group titled '<i>karchi project</i>' was created and all category A and B Conferences, that were mandated to contribute to the fund at ₦28,000 each, were added to it. He however noted that those that have been added haven't made any contribution yet.</p>

	<p>The Council President commented on the need for the said conferences to try and raise the funds for the project urging the grades A and B Conferences to see it as part of their service to the poor and make their contributions immediately. The Council hopes that by the next Central Council meeting, there will be a report on the execution of the project.</p>
<b>7.2</b>	<p><b>Update on St. Michael Sabon Gari Center in Bwari regarding the issue with Parish Priest:</b>  The Council President reported on behalf of the Zonal coordinator that upon the closure of the Society at St. Michael, Sabon Gari by the Parish Priest and his request for a letter from the Council which would prompt him to offer explanations for his actions, a letter was written and delivered. However, the Priest changed his mind and decided to meet with the members of the Center which the Council hopes will be for a resolution. The Council would await the feedback from the meeting before further actions can be taken.</p>
<b>7.3</b>	<p><b>Report of Postponed 12th March, 2022 zonal visitations:</b>  Bro. Fidelis Molokwu reported that the Gwagwalada zone had their visitation on the 14<sup>th</sup> of May, 2022 to Jesus the Abandoned Home at Kuje and it was successful.</p> <p>Bro. Chika Muobuike reported that the Life Camp Zone did their visitation on 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 to a home at Karu for orphaned and abandoned children and also those with terminal illnesses. The home is run by a missionary, Grandma Kathy. The visit was successful.</p> <p>Both Garki and Kubwa Zones had previously reported a successful visitation on the 12<sup>th</sup> of March.</p>
<b>7.4</b>	<p><b>Report of Prison Visitations for April, May and June, 2022:</b></p> <p><b>i. APRIL VISIT</b>  Sir. Vernatius Ezeama, the President of St. Martin, Lugbe reported that the visit took place on 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2022. Food items and toiletries were donated and the money for the release of five (5) inmates was paid for. Fourteen Vincentians went for the visit and all Conferences except Church of Transfiguration, Nuwalege made contributions.</p> <p><b>ii. MAY VISIT</b>  Bro. Emmanuel Obehighe reported that the visit took place on the 29<sup>th</sup> of May, 2022 and all the ten (10) Conferences participated, except St. Dominic, Kwali and St. Andrew, Orozo. Food items were donated and the sum of ₦168,000 was paid for the release of inmates.</p> <p>The Council President commented that St. Andrew, Orozo; St. Dominic Kwali; and Church of Transfiguration, Nuwalege would join the July group visit but still remain in their original groups for future visits.</p> <p><b>iii. JUNE VISIT</b>  Bro. Ukor Gerald the President of Holy Trinity, Maitama reported that the visit took place on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2022 and only three (3) Conferences participated. Food items were donated and the sum of ₦127,000 was paid for the release of eight (8) inmates. The Conferences that didn't Participate are</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>St. Josephine Bakhita, Jikwoyi</li> <li>St. Raphael, Garki</li> <li>St. Kizito, Kuje</li> <li>St. Anthony, Jabi</li> <li>Our Lady Queen of Hearts, Galadimawa</li> <li>Air Force Base Chaplaincy, Airport Road</li> <li>Church of Epiphany, Saburi</li> </ol> <p>The Patron of St. Kizito, Kuje, Bro. Valentine reported that they made a cash contribution directly to Fr. Victor.</p> <p>The Coordinator of St. Josephine Bakhita, Sis. Grace Attah reported that their car was stopped by VIO officers and were delayed. She said they finally got to Kuje and handed over their contribution to the Priest.</p> <p>The Council President highlighted that no Conference or Center is permitted to do the visit privately. Every visit must be made as a group and if for any reason any conference cannot make the visit, they can join the next month. He concluded by stating that the listed Conferences that did not make the visit should all join the July group and urged Holy Family, Life Camp to take note of the additions.</p>

7.5	<p><b>Report of National Council Annual General Meeting (AGM):</b></p> <p>Bro. Louis Tabai reported that the Council attended the meeting which held at Ede in Osun State from 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> June 2022. He said on 3<sup>rd</sup> June the day of arrival, there was a meeting of the Board members and the main meeting took place on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> June. He gave the following highlights from the meeting;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A lecture titled “<i>servicing with integrity – The Vincentian Way</i>” was presented by Rev. Fr. Cosmas Ukadike the National Spiritual Adviser.</li> <li>- Another lecture titled “<i>Plight of the Poor During a Global Crisis and the Role of the Christian Church</i>” was presented by Rev. Fr. Ayo Abe the Administrator of St. Augustine Pastoral center, Ede, Osun State.</li> <li>- The tenure of the former National President Mr. Kim Emmanuel came to an end during the AGM. In his farewell address, he highlighted the achievements and challenges faced during his tenure and was grateful for the opportunity to serve.</li> <li>- The issue with Lagos Central Council has been resolved as announced during the AGM. A caretaker committee has been put together to handle the affairs of the Council until an election is held.</li> <li>- The issue with Owerri Central Council had not yet been resolved. It was agreed at the meeting that the suspended former Owerri Central Council President Bro. Godwin Ewerem who was deeply involved with the crisis should write a letter of apology from whence further actions would be taken.</li> <li>- The election of the new National President was held and there were 3 candidates from Kaduna Metro where the position had been zoned to. Before the main election started, two of the nominated candidates stepped down leaving Mr. Francis Amole to be elected unopposed as the new National President of the society.</li> <li>- The new President announced his plans for the National Council which included to increase spirituality, embrace innovation and the use of technology for meetings where some could be done remotely.</li> </ul>																																		
7.6	<p><b>Report of FAMVIN Meeting:</b></p> <p>Sis. Joy Ohiagu Central Council Patroness reported that the meeting was held at St. Louise Provincial House of the Daughters of Charity, Nchia-Elеме in Rivers State from 29<sup>th</sup> April – 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2022. She gave the following highlights from the meeting;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The new President of FAMVIN Nigeria was presented at the meeting. His name is Fr. Cletus Kpalap. The New Vice President was also presented. Her name is Sister Ifeoma Arinze.</li> <li>- There was a lecture titled “<i>the plight of the poor</i>” which was presented by Fr. Flavio Pereira the Vice international coordinator.</li> <li>- There is need to enhance collaboration with all the arms of the FAMVIN family. This should also reflect on projects embarked upon as FAMVIN. A talk was also presented on this topic of collaboration by Rev. Prof. Igwe and Sis. Joy Ohiagu.</li> <li>- There had been a project to build 13 houses across the Country for poor people. Three (3) have been built remaining Ten (10).</li> <li>- The amended FAMVIN constitution was presented at the meeting by Sis. Joy Ohiagu.</li> <li>- Fr. Flavio spoke extensively on the need to have Confraternities of Professionals such as Lawyers, Doctors, Engineers, Teachers, graphic designers etc. within the FAMVIN family. Lawyers have already started theirs and on that note, she asked conference presidents to forward names of Vincentian Lawyers in their Conferences or Centers.</li> </ul>

<b>8.1</b>	<p><b>Gwagwalada Zone:</b></p> <p>The Zonal Coordinator, Bro. Fidelis Molokwu reported that the zone had its last meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. He further gave the following reports on their activities;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. The zone had their Easter food sharing on the scheduled date except St. Linus, Chika and St. Catherine, Giri.</li> <li>ii. There was inauguration of Holy Family, Gosa on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2022.</li> <li>iii. The Zone appreciates the Central Council for helping to galvanize support for the new born Baby with a growth on her back at St. Peter's, Abaji. Numerous donations were received and the ₦171,000 hospital bill has been paid.</li> <li>iv. St. Catherine, Giri; St. Peter de Apostle, Aco Estate; and St. Mary, Tudun Wada, Lugbe are ready for inauguration.</li> <li>v. The zone conducted awareness campaign and sensitization at; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>St. Peter &amp; Paul, Newsite, FHA Lugbe</li> <li>St. Monica, Sauka, Lugbe</li> <li>St. Mary's, Tudun Wada</li> <li>St. Anselm, Gwagwalada</li> </ul> </li> <li>vi. There was an issue at St. Linus, Chika which led to the resignation of the President Bro. Richard. It was caused by the supposed conflict between himself and the acting secretary and since January 2022, no meeting had been held there. The Parish pastoral Council of the Church took over the affairs of the society and a new acting President has emerged until an election can be held. Weekly meetings have also resumed.</li> <li>vii. There is a new coordinator for St. Mary's, Tudun Wada. Her name is Sis. Fidelia Nwabuchi. There is also a new coordinator at St. Monica, Sauka. Her name is Sis. Nkechi Enete.</li> <li>viii. There is a case of a master with sickle cell at St. Luke, Uni Abuja Teaching hospital. Some letters for support have been sent out and the zone is pleading with Conferences and Centers to assist them as regards.</li> <li>ix. A Vincentian from Sacred Heart, Gwagwalada has cancer and needs support but has refused to resign her membership. The zone pleads with Vincentians to individually assist. It was also noted that her current bills have been cleared by the parish choir and what she needs now is mostly feeding.</li> <li>x. The next zonal meeting comes up on the second Saturday in August at Infant Jesus, Iddo.</li> </ol> <p>The Central Council President announced that Holy Trinity, Maitama has offered to clear the debt of St. Mary's Tudun Wada upon the emergence of a new coordinator. He also announced that their inauguration has been approved but they are to propose a date for it. He also asked St. Peter de Apostle, Aco Estate to clear up their debt and choose a date for their inauguration.</p>
<b>8.2</b>	<p><b>Garki Zone:</b></p> <p>Bro. John Okoro reported that the zone had its last meeting/training on 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 at St. Damian Conference, Asokoro. He gave the following reports about the Zone;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. There is a new Conference President at St. Anthony Kabusa because of the differences between the parish priest and the former President. The name of the new President is Bro. Joseph Ugwu.</li> <li>ii. Consequently, St. Augustine, Waru has a new Coordinator in the person of Bro. Joachim Osigwe.</li> <li>iii. St. Kevin, Kabusa a new Center has appointed a Coordinator. Her name is Sis. Blessing Owan.</li> <li>iv. The President of St. Rita, Dakwo relocated to Lagos so an election was held and a new president emerged in the person of Bro. Felix Ogbuagwu.</li> <li>v. St. Augustine, Suncity has improved on their performance and their excos now attend Central Council and Zonal Meetings. The name of the new Coordinator is Sis. Helen Okolocha.</li> <li>vi. There is a new Coordinator for Holy Cross, Apo in the person of Bro. Tochukwu Uwakwe.</li> <li>vii. There is also a new Coordinator for St. Theresa, Wumba in the person of Bro. Richard Onuigbo.</li> </ol> <p>The Central Council President advised the new Coordinators in the Zone to take their new responsibility serious and called on the Zonal Coordinator to ensure they receive all the support and encouragement to carry out their new tasks.</p>
<b>8.3</b>	<p><b>Life Camp Zone:</b></p> <p>The Zonal Coordinator, Bro Chika Muobuike reported that the Zone which meets bimonthly had their last meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2022. He also made the following remarks and observations on its zonal activities;</p>

	<p>i. The Coordinator of St. Peter, Jiwa claimed that what the center needs is sensitization of existing members and not awareness campaign. The Zone has advised them to put their house together so that a new coordinator can be appointed.</p> <p>ii. The Coordinator of St. Fabian, Efab Life Camp Bro. Uzo Uhegbu claims that the Center has eighteen (18) members but only an average of five (5) attend meetings and are well supported by their Parish Priest. Holy Family Life Camp has been tasked to continue nurturing them.</p> <p>iii. St. Cyril Kado-Kuchi is ready for inauguration. They have fifteen (15) active members.</p> <p>iv. St. Brendan Jahi II are improving. They have eighteen (18) members of which nine (9) are very active.</p> <p>v. Holy Ghost, Saburi is doing well and are also nurturing some centers around them including St. Francis, Bagusa and Church of Annunciation, Saburi 1. Church of Annunciation lost a member named Barr. Edwin Nwabueze</p> <p>vi. St. Louis, Efab Estate is also doing very well and have 22 members of which 12 are very active. Their parish priest is also very supportive.</p> <p>vii. Bro. Sebastine Amechi is the new Coordinator of St. Mathew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa while Bro. Joseph Liku is the new Coordinator of St. Peter's, Idu.</p> <p>The Council President remarked that there should be awareness campaign at both centers followed by training specifically for them.</p>
9.0	<b>Other Matters:</b>
9.1	<p><b>Report of Central Council Youth Training:</b></p> <p>The Council Youth Coordinator Bro. Uformba Collins reported that the Youth training was held at St. Luke's, Kubwa on 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. The topic of the training was "<i>Application of Emotional Intelligence in the Vincentian Youth Apostolate</i>" taken by Fr. Bede Okolie and Bro. Marcel Anyatonwu. There were 78 registered participants and the total amount collected for registration was ₦77,000. Total expenditure was ₦15,150 so a total of ₦61,850 was refunded to the Central Council.</p>
9.2	<p><b>Report of 27<sup>th</sup> National Youth Coordinators Workshop:</b></p> <p>The Central Council Youth Coordinator Bro. Uformba Collins reported that himself and the former central council youth coordinator Bro. Fidelis Akomaye attended the workshop which took place at Divine Mercy pastoral Center, Obada, Abeokuta, Ogun State from 24<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. The theme of the workshop was "<i>Stronger Together: A Journey of Hope</i>". 9.3	<p><b>Report of Donation for Bro. Simplicus:</b></p> <p>The President reminded the Council about the call for donation and intervention for a Vincentian, Bro. Simplicus who was involved in ghastly motor accident while on Vincentian assignment. Direct contributions from members and not from the SSVF purse were made and a total of ₦1,650,000 had been sent to Port Harcourt for his care. A prayer for Simplicus which was composed by Sis. Ebere Ameh of Abuja Central Council has been adopted by the National Council. He concluded by urging all Conferences and Centers to keep praying for his healing.</p>
9.4	<p><b>Abuja Metropolitan Meeting Hosting:</b></p> <p>The Council President spoke about the upcoming Abuja Metropolitan Council meeting and said it is the turn of Abuja Central Council to host it. The last time Abuja Central Council hosted this meeting was five years ago. A committee has been set-up to plan for the hosting with the chairperson as Sis. Agatha Irabor, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President of Abuja Central Council.</p>

	<p>Sis. Agatha Irabor spoke on current plans and actions of the committee. She highlighted the terms of reference and objectives of the Committee as follows;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Plan for the hosting of the Metro Council meeting from 19-21 August, 2022.</li> <li>2. Arrange for the venue and accommodation.</li> <li>3. Arrange for possible courtesy visit to the Archbishop.</li> <li>4. Develop a theme for the meeting.</li> <li>5. Develop a topic for the talk to be given and arrange for a resource person.</li> <li>6. Plan for feeding and entertainment.</li> <li>7. Plan for the printing of banners and brochure and other materials.</li> <li>8. Plan for gala night after the event.</li> <li>9. Other necessary things as may be thought out by the Committee.</li> </ol> <p>Based on these terms, the subcommittees of Liturgy, Transportation, Finance and Accommodation/administration were constituted and the Proposed budget for the hosting was ₦1,057,250. She noted that the host conference, OLQN, Garki has offered to take care of the Gala night in the evening of the second day of the meeting.</p> <p>The Council President spoke again and highlighted the importance of Conferences and Centers to pay their levies. He noted that paying of levies is as important as taking care of a master because all the work the higher councils do is still for the betterment of masters and the Council has no other source of funding than from levies. He further noted that the hosting of the Metro meeting has been captured in the 2022 budget of the Council which is part of the 2022 levies to the Conferences and Centers.</p> <p>He urged Presidents and Coordinators to try and pay their levies and could do so in installments so that the Council would not be levied for the hosting.</p> <p>He concluded by saying that Conferences would be contacted to pay up their levies and also contribute towards the hosting of the metro meeting.</p>															
<p><b>9.5</b></p>	<p><b>Submission of Half Year Reports:</b></p> <p>The Council President spoke on the importance of submission of reports and said that the Abuja Central Council is also expected to submit its report at the upcoming Metro Meeting. Some Conferences and Centers gave various reasons why they had not submitted theirs but the CC President said it is absolutely inexcusable and noted that the Council has organized several trainings on report writing but members still make errors on format and also on timeline of submission. He stated that if the report booklets owned by almost all Conferences and Centers are duly filled, the absence of a President or any other responsible member should also not hinder the report writing. He gave until Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July for final submission of the reports.</p>															
<p><b>9.6</b></p>	<p><b>Report on St. Pius X, Gbagalape:</b></p> <p>The Zonal Coordinator Bro. Bonaventure Nwokpor reported that for some time there was an issue at the Conference that led to the stoppage of activities by the Parish Priest. The Central Council had been intervening and the issue has finally been resolved. A sensitization tour was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2022 and an interim President was appointed for a tenure of 6 months after which an election would be held. They have now resumed meetings but so far, the Priest has not allowed them to use the Alms Boxes.</p> <p>He introduced the interim President in the Person of Bro. Ugwu Okafor. <p><b>9.9</b></p>	<p><b>Report of Abuja Central Council 1<sup>st</sup> Biannual Training:</b></p> <p>Bro Bonaventure Nwokpor the Council training officer reported that the training themed “Leadership Development and Vincentian Spirituality” took place at St. John Mary Vianney, Kubwa on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2022. There were 161 participants from 46 Conferences and 97 participants from 40 Centers in attendance. Some members after sending money for registration did not show up at all.</li> <li>- A total income of ₦477,515 was generated while total expenditure was ₦302,300 leaving a balance of ₦175,215.</li> </ul> <p>The Council President in his remarks commended the training team and assured the commitment of the Council to improvements going forward. He also expressed dismay about the reports of members that left after registration and some that did not come at all. He advised Presidents and Coordinators to demand for reports from members that are sent for trainings.</p>
<b>9.10</b>	<p><b>Conference Inauguration Reports:</b></p> <p>Bro. Godwin Amaa, the President of Holy Family, Gosa reported that the inauguration of his Conference which took place on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 was successful and on behalf of his Parish Priest and members, thanked the Central Council Board and the Zonal coordinator for the kind effort towards achieving the inauguration.</p> <p>Sis. Rita Ikere, the President of St. Mathew, Ushafa also reported that the inauguration at her conference which took place on June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022 was successful. She also thanked the entire Abuja Central Council board for the approval and actualization of the inauguration.</p> <p>The Council President announced that the inauguration of St. Josephine Bakhita, Jikwoyi would come up on the 7<sup>th</sup> of August, 2022 during the 10.00am Mass.</p>
<b>9.11</b>	<p><b>Abuja Central Council 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary:</b></p> <p>The Council President announced that the Abuja Central council was instituted in 1993 and consequently, next year 2023 would be her 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary which the Council has decided to mark. Modalities would be put in place and committees constituted to mark the event.</p>
<b>9.12</b>	<p><b>Management of Masters sent to University of Abuja Teaching Hospital, Gwagwalada:</b></p> <p>The Council President noted that the Council has received reports that in instances when the masters of some Conferences and Centers are referred to the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital at Gwagwalada, they are sometimes abandoned and asked to seek continued support from either or both St. Paul and Sacred Heart Gwagwalada thereby increasing the burden of the two Conferences. He advised any Conference or Center in such circumstance to continue with the financial care of their masters to the best of their ability but still liaise with the Conferences at Gwagwalada for check -ups and updates.</p>
<b>9.13</b>	<p><b>Food Sharing Timing:</b></p> <p>The Council President announced that reports have been received of some Conferences/Centers that choose to commence their food sharing before the Council announced time of 10.00am. He noted with dismay that most of those decisions are often done for personal interest as members want to quickly conclude and go home ignoring the implication that masters that have received food items can quickly go to another location to receive same. He advised all Conferences/Centers to adhere strictly to the agreed time for sharing no matter the circumstance.</p>
<b>9.14</b>	<p><b>Master at St. Mathew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa:</b></p> <p>The Council President spoke about the call for support by St. Mathew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa for a master in their care. He noted that only one Conference, St. John Mary Vianney, Lugbe has donated. He urged Presidents and Coordinators to please contribute the much they can towards the care of the master who needs surgery to be able to walk again.</p>
<b>9.15</b>	<p><b>Availability of SSVP National Uniform:</b></p> <p>The Council President apologized for the delays in the delivery of the Uniforms stating that the fault is not from the Central Council. The Council had expected to receive the uniforms during the last AGM but the issues from the factory had not yet been finalized. He announced that the National Council is totally in charge of the uniforms and hopefully would be delivered in due time.</p>
<b>10.0</b>	<p><b>AOB:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Bro. Christopher Chukwu the President of St. Christopher, Games Village announced that they lost a Benefactor named Mr. Emeka Duru. Also, one of their members had a brain surgery which cost ₦7.1m. The Parish Priest approved a fund raising and also members did free will donations and were able to raise about ₦3m to support. Also, their former Vice President relocated so they have a new one in the person of Sis. Lilian.</li> <li>ii. Sis. Evelyn Ataguba, the President of CKC, Kurudu asked about the donation of ₦10m worth of treatment and a dedicated hospital from a benefactor during the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration last year. She wonders if Bro. Simplicus cannot benefit from it.</li> </ol>

	<p>The Council President in his response noted that there has been follow up but the hospital has actually not started.</p> <p>iii. Joseph Uba from St. Pius X, Gbagalape asked why the earlier reported member of SSVP that had cancer had been asked to resign despite her commitment and the seriousness of her illness.</p> <p>The Council President in his response stated that the rule that governs the society worldwide does not permit any member or direct family of a member the right to benefit from the purse of the society. It is clearly written in our manuals that members that want to benefit must resign. Only freewill donations can be done.</p> <p>iv. Bro. Ipenyi Sylvester the President of Holy Cross, Gwarimpa announced that his Conference lost two masters namely 'Lawrence Duru' and 'Franca Nwachukwu'. A member lost his wife in the person of Ifeoma Chieweke while another member lost his Father Mr. Lazarus Ugwu. He concluded by also announcing the passing of his own father, Mr. Gabriel Ipenyi.</p> <p>v. Sis. Elizabeth Ogidan from Guardian Angel, Lugbe noted that changes needed to be made to the figures announced as indebtedness to Conferences because the amount announced for her conference is did not reflect the payments they had made.</p> <p>The Central Council President commented that there might be errors in the reported figures and advised Conferences and Centers to go to the financial team with their receipts of payments for reconciliation. He also noted that these debts are accumulated from many years ago, not just from this year and the break down is stated clearly in the document.</p> <p>vi. Bro. Sunday Mathew, the Assistant Coordinator of St. Peter's, Abaji thanked the Central Council for the support and also asked how they can send an appreciation to their Parish Priest. He also complained about the late start of the Central Council meeting.</p> <p>The Council President advised them to appreciate their Priest by themselves. On the issue of timing and late start to meetings he said the Priest was ready to start Holy Mass at the given time but members had not shown up. He advised members to come early for meetings.</p> <p>vii. Chukwu Calista the secretary of St. Anthony, Gbessa asked how to handle the situation that St. Andrew Sauka sent two masters to them without pre-information or asking if they have the resources to handle it. She also asked if a relative of a member of the society in another location can benefit from the society.</p> <p>The Council President responded by stating that the most important issue concerning attending to masters is jurisdiction. If a fellow center sends a master that is also within the same general jurisdiction, you can assist after communication with the Center. Concerning relatives of members benefiting, the council President stated that relatives of a member but in a different location or conference can meet the society for help. The main concern the rule prohibits are direct family members like wife and children and also within the same conference or council.</p> <p>viii. Sis. Ebere Ameh, the President of St. Benedict, Lokogoma announced that she turned 50yrs old on the 14<sup>th</sup> of July, 2022 so she would be cutting a cake at the meeting. She also gave a testimony about a diagnosis she received in 2001 about a malignancy and was told that she would live for about 9 years. She was also told to avoid getting pregnant of which she became pregnant around that time and refused to terminate it even with the doctor's insistence. She stated that she successfully gave birth and the child is now 20yrs old. She also shared how she miraculously recovered her car and properties inside when she was robbed at gun point while as a member of CIWA, Port Harcourt.</p>
