

**Minutes of the Meeting of the International Confederation of the Society of St. Vincent De Paul (SSVP), Abuja
Central Council Held at St. Agnes Conference, Wuye on 9th April, 2022.**

1.0	Attendance A total of One Hundred and Ninety Six (196) Vincentians were in attendance at the meeting. Details are as shown on pages 11, 12, 13 and 14.
2.0	Opening The meeting started at 10.37am with a prayer said by Bro. Kanu S. Luke, the Conference president of Holy Spirit, Byazhin.
3.0	Spiritual Reading The Spiritual reflection at the meeting which was based on the reading with the theme: <i>“Three can be greater than Ten”</i> , from page 60 of the Manual of the Society (4 th Edition Reprint), was taken by Bro. Isidore Udenko, the Conference President of St. Agnes, Wuye. In his reflection, he noted that the reading is much applicable in recent times because of the availability of only few persons when it comes to carrying out Vincentian work and that even the few that are available are usually faced with numerous challenges such as vain benefactors that insist on how their contributions are shared and also the overwhelming number of masters that flock different conferences and centers. He concluded by stating that by the grace of God, we would always be able to achieve the great works of the society. The Central Council President, Bro. Ugochukwu Anaedobe in his contribution emphasized the need for Vincentians to contribute more time towards the work of the society rather than just being associate members. From our reports it is often obvious that only a few members are active in our Conferences and Centers and it ought not to be so. He urged all Vincentians to do more in that regard.
4.0	Opening Remarks by the Council President: The Council President thanked God for the gift of life and for giving everyone the grace to attend the meeting. He noted that although the society is a special one that should not be taken lightly because it provides a pedestal for its members to make heaven, it is also unique in the sense that it holds members accountable to the extent that if one is not careful, it can also lead one to hell. Vincentians would be held accountable even though they joined the society voluntarily. He also talked about the oneness of the society as it tries to build a network of charity worldwide where what troubles one Conference automatically troubles another. That is the reason why international and local conferences are twinned to each other because we are all working towards the same goal and he urged stronger Conferences to always support weaker ones both materially and spiritually. In conclusion, he reminded Conference Presidents and Center Coordinators that they are the eye of the Council just the way Ministers and their Ministries are meant to carry out the policies of the Government. There is no room for grandstanding or spectatorship. The policies of the Central Council should be owned by them and all important information must be taken back to Conferences and Centers with strict adherence.
5.0	Welcome Remarks by the Host Conference President: Bro. Isidore Udenko, Host Conference President welcomed all Vincentians in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. He remarked that the Conference was formed in 2004 and inaugurated in 2007. He noted that he is the third President since the inauguration and they have had serious challenges but just like the spiritual reading highlighted, the fact that three can be greater than ten is always exemplified in their Conference. He agreed with the Council President that the buck of the responsibility lies with the Presidents and Coordinators. He further spoke on the gains of twinning especially the international ones because his Conference is at the verge of establishing a twinning relationship with a conference in the United States of America but the process is being delayed. He urged the Council to ensure that the process is concluded as soon as possible to enable them reap the benefits that accrues from such relationship In his response, the Central Council President noted that since it seems the host conference is having membership issues, they should liaise with their Parish Priest who is supportive of the society to organize membership campaigns in the Church. The Zonal Coordinator should also be involved. On the twinning, the Council President noted that the work is currently ongoing and the approval lies with the National Council President.

6.0	<p>Welcome Remarks by the Parish Priest of St. Agnes Conference, Wuye: The Parish Priest Rev. Fr. Peter Belikan on behalf of his Parishioners welcomed Vincentians to the meeting and prayed for fruitful deliberations. He noted that every baptized Christian should be a member of the society because the work it does is a core Christian duty emphasized by Jesus Christ himself. He urged Vincentians to continue making sacrifices and prayed that God in his infinite wisdom and mercy would continue to bless us. He concluded by wishing all members safe arrival to their destinations after the meeting.</p> <p>In his response, the Council President stated that the council had heard about the numerous support shown to the Society and thanked the Parish Priest immensely. He added that the society experiences different levels of support from various parishes but those that receive the type currently enjoyed by the host conference always have the sky as their limit. He concluded by urging all Conferences to always carry their parish priests along by constantly giving reports both financial and otherwise as it creates trust and confidence.</p>

7.1	<p>Reading of Minutes, Observations, Corrections and Amendments: The minutes of the previous meeting held at St. Donald Conference, Karu on 22nd January, 2022 was studied by all present and the following observations/corrections were made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Page 4(9.3): Bro. Valentine Onwuegbu the President of St. Kizito, Kuje noted that contrary to what is reported in the minutes, food sharing actually took place at St. Kizito, Kuje. ii. Page 6(11.0, vii): Bro. Emmanuel Umeano noted that his last name was wrongly spelt as “<i>Emeano</i>”.
7.2	<p>Adoption of Minutes: In the absence of further corrections & observations, a motion for the adoption of the minutes was moved by Sis. Elizabeth Ogidan, the President of Guardian Angel Police Chaplaincy, Lugbe and was seconded by Bro. Samson Damisah, the President of CKC, Kurudu.</p>

9.0	<p>Matters Arising from the Minutes:</p>
9.1	<p>Update on Ozanam House Project: Sis. Agatha Irabor, on behalf of the Committee Chairman reported that a letter had been written to the Hon. Minister of the FCT as a reminder of the discussions at the last meeting the Council had with him during the 60th Anniversary courtesy visit. The outcome of the letter, she added was a visit to the plot in March 2022 for inspection by three (3) staff of the FCDA on the instruction of the Hon. Minister. It is hoped that by the next Council meeting in July, there would more update in this regard.</p> <p>The Council President added that our Project supervisor is currently meeting with members of the National Assembly to see if the issue of the access road could be carried out as a constituency project. He also reminded Conferences and Centers to continue saying the prayer for the realization of the Ozanam House project and finally for Presidents and Coordinators to try to ensure their members pay the minimum annual contribution of ₦1,000 each.</p>
9.2	<p>Update on the location of ‘Old Karchi’ Settlement under Gwagwalada Area Council: Bro. Kola Olumolu, the President of St. Paul’s Conference, Gwagwalada reported that the settlement has been located and they met the Parish Priest who identified the issues faced in the community amongst which was their school that needs about fifty (50) seats and desks which cost ₦10,000 each. It amounts to ₦500,000.</p> <p>The Council President formally announced to all Grade A and B Conferences to expect to be contacted for this project and that it is an aspect of the network of charity he spoke about earlier in the meeting. He urged the President of St. Paul’s Conference Gwagwalada to go ahead and contact the conference presidents to raise funds towards the project.</p>
9.3	<p>Update on St. Fabian, Efab & Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Galadima: The Zonal Coordinator, Bro. Chika Muobike reported that St. Fabian presently is doing well. They now being nurtured by Holy Family Life Camp and attend their activities.</p>

	Regarding Our Lady of Perpetual Help, he noted they have also improved and are present at the meeting. Their Presidents tenure has elapsed and they would also be submitting their notification for election during the meeting.
9.4	<p>Update on Society of St. Vincent de Paul in Daughters of Charity: Sis. Joy Ohiagu reported that she had been liaising with Bro. Nicholas Ekeke, the President of St. John Mary Vianney, Kubwa who has attended their meetings and they meet every Tuesday morning. She noted that they are not very conversant with the rules of the society because they are all new and all work at the hospital but are currently being put through about the society. They have bought manuals and have been taught how to write minutes and reports.</p>
9.5	<p>Update on Sabon Gari Center in Bwari on issue with Parish Priest: The Zonal coordinator, Sis. Chika Atep reported that they visited the Parish Priest on 27th March, 2022 to ask why the society was dissolved and he asked that a letter be written to him formally so that he can respond in writing.</p> <p>The Council President announced that during the Board meeting, it had been decided that the Council would write the letter to the Priest which would be done soon.</p>
9.6	<p>Update on Raffle ticket submission: A sizable number of Conferences and Centers had not submitted their raffle tickets and most had similar excuses such as lost copies by members, members refusing to return the tickets and members with tickets that are unreachable or have moved out of Abuja. The President of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Galadima reported that their Conference office was demolished which led to the destruction and misplacement of the tickets.</p> <p>Some tickets were however returned and the Council President mandated all Conferences and Centers to return all sold or unsold tickets by Friday, 15th April, 2022.</p>
9.7	<p>Report of 12th March, 2022 joint visitation: Bro. Chika Muobuike reported that the Life Camp Zone would be doing their visitation after Easter.</p> <p>Bro. Fidelis Molokwu reported that the Gwagwalada zone has fixed their visitation for the 14th of May, 2022 to an orphanage home at Kuje.</p> <p>Bro. Bonaventure Nwokpor reported that Karu Zone has fixed the 28th of May, 2022 for the joint visitation at Nyanya General Hospital.</p> <p>Sister Chika Atep reported that Kubwa zone has done their visitation to a Center at Zuba called St. Anthony Mary Claret, Gofina and it was very successful.</p> <p>Bro. Emmanuel Obehighe reported on behalf of the Garki zone that the visitation was done successfully on the 12th of March, 2022 and almost all Conferences and Centers in the zone contributed but only three (3) were able to make it on the day of visitation.</p> <p>The Council President responded by stating that the reasons given for the delay wasn't cogent enough and would no longer be tolerated and commended those that have carried out the visitation.</p>
9.8	<p>Report of Metro Council Meeting: Bro. Chika Muobuike reported that the Council attended the meeting which held at Makurdi from 11th to 13th March, 2022. A lecture was presented on the challenges facing the Society of St. Vincent de Paul due to the prevailing insecurity in the Country and the Bishop of Makurdi diocese who was present spoke passionately about the challenges faced in Benue due to the insecurity crisis in the Country. He said they have six (6) IDPs in Makurdi alone and there are about 400 children with no parents that the Church takes care of their education.</p> <p>He also added that the chaplain advised Vincentians and Catholics to get involved with the forthcoming elections and register to get their PVCs.</p> <p>He concluded by stating that all financial issues with the Metro Council has been resolved as the Abuja Central Council has cleared all its indebtedness.</p> <p>The Council President added that annual reports by Councils were submitted and analyzed with scrutiny after which Abuja Central Council produced the best report. He urged Conferences and Centers to refrain from submitting their reports late.</p>
9.9	<p>Report of Prison Visitations for January, February and March, 2022:</p> <p>i. JANUARY VISIT Bro. Collins Uformba reported that the January visit went as scheduled but some Conferences did not participate. Sacred Heart Airport and Our Lady Queen of Peace Utako came with their Centers in good</p>

numbers while Pope John Paul II, Kubwa reportedly contributed ₦10,000 out of the ₦50,000 that was apportioned to all grade A and B conferences.

The Council President commented that there is an updated list which has been shared and urged Conferences to be proactive by reaching out to their group coordinator even if he or she hasn't done so. He added that it is advisable to contribute early so that planning could be done conveniently.

ii. FEBRUARY VISIT

Bro. Obi Onwuegbusi reported that out of the eleven (11) Conferences, only St. Andrew, Sauka did not participate in the visitation because they allegedly did theirs in January. Twenty-four Vincentians made the visit and were all allowed to interact with the prisoners. Items were donated by all Conferences and out of the 15 inmates who had an option of fine for their release, 12 were released due to their intervention while the remaining 3 were released at a later date. Payments for their release were deposited into the bank account provided by the Chaplain and the following Conferences were responsible for the respective number of released prisoners:

The Council President commended the February group and advised that henceforth, all such reports be written neatly or typed and submitted to the Central Council.

iii. MARCH VISIT

Sis. Jayne Okoh reported on behalf of the March group. The visit took place on 27th March, 2022 and was led by St. Donald, Karu joined by two other Conferences namely Arch Angels, Durumi and Our Lady of Fatima, Karomagiji. ₦37,000 was jointly contributed and handed over to the Prison Chaplain. No food item was donated.

Sis. Linda Njoku apologized for getting the update late and not contacting their coordinating Conference. Sis. Chinyere Agim of St. Anthony, Gbessa said they had already gone with the January group.

The Council President highlighted that Conferences should not join their mother Conferences within their area for prison visitation but rather follow the published list. The prison visitation schedule is different from zonal visits.

He advised the April group to get prepared for their visit.

9.10 Reports of Elections:

10.0 Zonal Reports:

10.1 Gwagwalada Zone:

The Zonal Coordinator, Bro. Fidelis Molokwu reported that the Zone meets bimonthly and their last meeting was on 12th March, 2022 at Sacred Heart, Gwagwalada. He further gave the following reports on their activities:

- i. The zone which covers Conferences and Centers in airport road, Kuje and Gwagwalada axis comprises of 11 Conferences and 23 active Centers.
- ii. They have commenced sensitization and membership drive for 2022 starting with Holy Ghost Pastoral Center, Gudaba on 13th March and they shall be visiting SS Peter & Paul, FHA New Site Lugbe on 10th April, 2022.
- iii. The Zone would be having a joint visitation on 14th May, 2022 to an orphanage home at Kuje.
- iv. Due to the need for training new members, Sis. Chinwe Okafor has been appointed by the Zone as a zonal training officer. So far, they have successfully held a training exercise at St. Paul, Gwagwalada for Conferences and Centers around it and the turnout was encouraging.
- v. The zone is clamoring for inauguration of the following Centers
 - a. Holy Family, Gosa. (May 29th)
 - b. St. Mary, Tudun Wada, Lugbe. (July)
 - c. St. Peter de Apostle, Aco Estate, Sabon Lugbe.
- vi. The Zone is preparing for the Easter food sharing.
- vii. Contrary to the observation raised from the minutes, there was actually no evidence of Christmas food sharing at St. Kizito, Kuje.
- viii. Their next meeting comes up on the 14th of May, 2022 at St. Kizito, Kuje.

10.2 Kubwa Zone:

The Zonal Coordinator, Sis. Chika Atep gave the following reports on their activities:

- i. They had their last meeting on the 6th of April, 2022.
- ii. They had a sensitization and membership drive at St. Williams, Pwambara on 20th March, 2022 after which about 32 persons indicated interest in joining the Society. The Zone donated 2 alms boxes and a manual to the center.
- iii. The zone is clamoring for inauguration of the following Centers;
 - a. St. Mathew, Ushafa (26th June)

	b. St. Edwin, Tutu, Kubwa (September)
10.3	<p>Life Camp Zone: The Zonal Coordinator, Bro Chika Muobuikwe reported that the Zone which meets bimonthly had their last meeting on 19th February, 2022 at St. Peter Jiwa. He also made the following remarks and observations on its zonal activities;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Parish Priest at St. Peter Jiwa reported them that they are not doing things correctly and even though he has approved an awareness campaign, the coordinator hasn't been able to provide a date for it. ii. St. Mathew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa had about 15 members when an awareness campaign was done there but now have only about 4 members. iii. The Parish Priest at St. Joseph, Gwagwa has asked that the society be started there which would be done soon. iv. St. Martins Center, Mabuchi is a new center and is being nurtured by Holy Cross, Gwarimpa. v. St. Cyril, Kadokuchi is a vibrant Center and is due for inauguration. They would be presented at the next Council meeting. vi. The zone will hold its next meeting at St. Louis EFAB Global. <p>Bro. Munonye Richard the Coordinator of St. Peter Jiwa complained that the main problem with the center is the attitude of its members. He spoke about how the Parish Priest once asked them to come in a minimum of 4 persons to collect ₦50,000 but for over 3 months, himself and the secretary were not able to gather that number of persons to meet with the Priest.</p> <p>Bro. Eze Sebastine the treasurer of St. Mathew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa also complained about membership and that since Covid-19 lockdown eased, only about four (4) members come for meeting. The Center also needs a new Coordinator as the previous one is engaged with their parish laity council.</p> <p>The Council President remarked that there should be awareness campaign at both centers followed by training specifically for them.</p>
10.4	<p>Karu Zone: The Zonal Coordinator Bro. Nwokpor Bonaventure reported that they had their last meeting on 2nd April, 2022 at St. Mary's, Karu. He gave the following reports on their activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Many centers and conferences in the zone did not do well in the timely submission of annual reports and a lot of work has been done to ensure it doesn't happen again. ii. The Zone is also planning Zonal training in June. iii. The Zone is planning for Easter food sharing and he pleaded with well to do Conferences in other zones to lend some assistance due to the peculiarity of Karu zone especially as they share border with Nasarawa State. iv. A new center, Divine Mercy has been identified and is being nurtured by St. Ignatius, Karu. v. Concerning St. Joseph the Worker, Kugbo, they have no members and needs to be revived. It had been assumed that they weren't under Karu Zone. vi. St. Kevin, Jikwoyi which moved to an interior location as a result of the creation of Pastoral centers is now faced with serious membership and financial issues just as the Center, St. Josephine Bakhita which occupies their former location is now vibrant because the members refused to move with St. Kevin. This is a unique situation but he called on the Central Council to quickly inaugurate St. Josephine Bakhita so they could administratively take on more responsibilities. vii. St. Pius X, Gbagalape's issues with their Parish Priest are likely to be resolved as the Priest has confirmed a reopening after Easter. He thanked the Central Council President and Matron for their intervention.
10.5	<p>Garki Zone: Sis. Ebere Ameh on behalf of the Garki Zonal Coordinator gave the following reports about the Zone.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Zone visited St. Mary's Orphanage on the 19th of March, 2022. ii. The Zone is organizing a training on annual reports. iii. The zone visited St. Peters Center, Damangaza.
11.0	Other Matters:
11.1	<p>Update on Central Council Training: The Council President announced that there has been a restructuring of the training program in the Council to ensure uniformity. The Council Training Officer, Bro. Bonaventure Nwokpor added that all Conferences and Centers need to align their trainings with the Council by firstly identifying training needs so that the Council can organize a curriculum for the sake of uniformity of information Vincentians are being trained on. He noted that any Conference or Center that is</p>

	<p>organizing any training must let the Central Council know for the same reasons and urged all Conferences to fill out the training needs forms. Post training Assessment feedback forms are also to be filled out after each training so that suggestions are noted and improvements can be made.</p> <p>The Council Training officer also announced that the topic for the next Council training is 'Leadership Development and Vincentian Spirituality' and it comes up on the 21st of May, 2022. The Conferences are to pay ₦5,000 for 3 persons while Centers are to pay ₦3,000 for 2 members. He advised that Presidents, Secretaries and Training Officers are amongst the key persons to attend the training. If there is need to add an extra participant, Conferences would pay ₦1,500 per extra participant while Centers pay ₦1,000.</p>																												
11.2	<p>Annual & Quarterly Reports:</p> <p>The Council President announced that the Board decided that four (4) reports would be submitted every year. Two quarterly reports, One half year report and one annual report. The details are as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The First quarter report which is a photocopy of filled Annual Report Booklet from January to March of each year. - The second report to be submitted is the half year report which should be packaged in the same format as annual reports using the two separate sheets. It should contain all records from January to the end of June of each year. - The third report to be submitted is the 3rd quarter report which is a photocopy of the filled report booklet for the months of July, August and September. - The final report to be submitted would be the standard annual report from January to December of each year. 																												
11.3	<p>Strengthening Zonal Monitoring Groups & Creation of Particular Councils:</p> <p>The Council President announced that more experienced people would be working with the Zonal Coordinators because of the enormous nature of the job. Past Presidents that are very vested in the activities of the society would be called upon to join the zonal monitoring groups.</p> <p>Similarly, the Council President spoke on <i>Particular Council's</i> and its usefulness. Particular Councils are lower councils that oversee Conferences but also work under and report to the Central Council. It is sometimes necessitated when the geographical span of the Central Council is very broad and when few conferences are in close proximity with each other but a far distance away from the others within a Council.</p> <p>Consequently, the Board is planning to create a Particular Council for the Gwagwalada axis which spans all the way to Abaji. The modalities would be communicated when the plans have been concluded.</p>																												
11.5	<p>SOS Request from Makurdi Central Council:</p> <p>The Council President spoke about the SOS request from Makurdi Central Council concerning a master domiciled in the jurisdiction of St. Mary Conference Makurdi who gave birth to twins prematurely and the bill accumulated to ₦1.6m. They reduced the debt to ₦700,000 and Abuja Central Council was contacted. The Council contacted a few Conferences and they raised ₦330,000 for the case. The contributing Conferences were;</p> <p>Holy Trinity, Maitama CKC, Kubwa Our Lady Queen of Nigeria, Garki Guardian Angel, Lugbe St. Damian, Asokoro</p> <p>A total of ₦330,000 was raised and sent directly to the bank account of the hospital.</p> <p>The Council President announced that Holy Trinity Conference, Maitama has decided to add another ₦100,000 to the same amount they had contributed for the case. This would now make the total contribution from Abuja Central Council, ₦430,000.</p>																												
11.6	<p>Support for a Master at St. Peter Abaji:</p> <p>The Council President announced that St. Peter's Abaji has a 3 months old baby they are catering for who underwent surgery because of a growth on her back. The outstanding debt is ₦171,000 and they are calling on Conferences and Centers to come to their aid. In the same vein, the Council President acknowledged the receipt of a letter from St. Mathew Police Chaplaincy, Gwagwa requesting for assistance for a master Idoko Uzochukwu. The master needs surgery for knee replacement which amounts to about ₦1.9m.

The Council president advised that when such issues arise, the Conferences should communicate with each other because the Council does not have the funds and relies only on the levies paid by Conferences and Centers. What the Council can do is to share the message for support but not to provide funds for the case. He however asked them to provide their Bank account which would be placed on the WhatsApp Platform.

12.0 AOB:

i. Bro. Amanobi Nwinne the secretary of St. Andrew, Orozo asked about the fee Centers are to pay for training. The Central Council President responded by restating the figures. Centers are to pay ₦3,000 for two persons and an extra ₦1,000 each for additional persons if any.

ii. Bro. Gerald Ukor the President of Holy Trinity, Maitama announced the death of their master Simon Aaron.

iii. Sis. Elizabeth Ogidan the President of Guardian Angel, Lugbe asked the Council to publish the number of raffle tickets given to each Conference so they can check their records.

iv. Bro. Marcel Anyatonwu the President of St. Luke's, Kubwa suggested if templates could be made for giving reports such as prison visits and zonal activities so that they could be concise but detailed enough to save time.

The Council President noted that he had already announced that prison visits and other such reports be written neatly or typed and submitted during meetings. Also, he observed that the main reason the council meeting lasts long is because it starts late due to late coming of members. He urged members to try and be prompt henceforth.

v. Bro. Ipenyi Sylvester the President of Holy Cross, Gwarimpa said that his Conference is handling the case of a 20yr old boy with end stage Kidney disease. He said that of the ₦15m needed for the transplant, the family has been able to raise ₦5m. He pleaded with all Vincentians that are moved to contribute towards the treatment.

vi. Bro. Emmanuel Umeano from St. Joseph Mukasa, Gidan Mangoro announced that the Laity Council in collaboration with INEC is organizing voter registration for deaneries in Abuja.

vii. Bro. Mbachu Charles, the Vice President of Arch Angels, Gaduwa announced that he was recently involved in a ghastly accident but his life was saved. He is grateful to Garki Zone for their support and prayers.

viii. Bro. John Emmanuel the President of St. John the Beloved, Tunga Maje announced that they lost a Master named Angela Echizona. Also, a member lost her mother in the person of Mrs. Agnes Njoku.

ix. Bro. Robert Ogom the Training officer at St. Charles Lwanga, Apo asked that if benefactors would relax with the support they give if they realize that Conferences have projects that generate money?

The Council President in his response stated that benefactors would not be deterred by upcoming or ongoing projects. They would actually be involved because the contributions of the society alone usually cannot set up a viable project that can be seen as self-sustainable.

x. Bro. Gerald Ajoku the President of St. Monica, Byazhin announced that two members of his Conference would be getting married on the 30th of April, 2022 and they are inviting the Council.

The Council President urged the Kubwa Zonal Coordinator to mobilize their members to support the couple.

xi. Bro. Shij Aondoakura, the Youth Coordinator of St. Agnes, Wuye observed that there are so many editions of the Society's manual of which the readings and other chapters appear on different pages. He expressed his displeasure as regards and asks if the numerous versions and revisions were done for the purpose of raising funds.

The Council President in his response noted that those manuals were produced by the National Council and not the Abuja Central Council. He added that there were some amendments that were made by the National Council that necessitated the various versions we are seeing.

Sis. Joy Ohiagu also added that two of the reprints of the 4th Edition had typographical errors which led to the reprinting.

xii. Sis. Joy Ohiagu spoke concerning the uniforms. She apologized on behalf of the Council and explained that the delay came from the National Council because the order received from the factory wasn't sufficient so they supplied Councils that ordered smaller quantities first. Abuja ordered for 250 pieces and she promised that when the uniforms arrive, it would be supplied to those who paid first.

She also spoke about Justice Development and Peace Commission (JDPC) and explained that their roles are interwoven with that of SSVP. She urged Vincentians not to have conflict with them but rather collaborate by sending masters that have court related issues, marriage abuse, housing issues to them. She added that the Lenten collection collected is shared by the Arch Diocese and 20% gets to all Parishes and the money is supposed to be shared by JDPC, SSVP and Church Welfare.

Lastly she commented that the INEC registration activity is not spearheaded by the Laity Council but rather the JDPC.
